H 686:	Rep. Andrus presented H 686 . This legislation revisits the ghosting bill presented in committee with amendments. Notably, the bill proposed requiring individuals to conduct five work searches within a seven-day period, alongside introducing modified language pertaining to interviews. This bill aims to address the issue of ghosting in employment situations, providing a structured framework for job seekers while incorporating necessary adjustments to streamline processes and enhance clarity.
MOTION:	Rep. Weber made a motion to send H 686 to the floor with a DO PASS recommendation. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Cheatum, Rep. Chew (Schmich), and Rep. Roberts requested they be recorded as voting NAY. Rep. Andrus will sponsor the bill on the floor.
