Chairman Holtzclaw called the meeting to order at 1:29 pm.
H 686: **Rep. Andrus** presented **H 686**. This legislation revisits the ghosting bill presented in committee with amendments. Notably, the bill proposed requiring individuals to conduct five work searches within a seven-day period, alongside introducing modified language pertaining to interviews. This bill aims to address the issue of ghosting in employment situations, providing a structured framework for job seekers while incorporating necessary adjustments to streamline processes and enhance clarity.
MOTION: **Rep. Weber** made a motion to send **H 686** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Cheatum, Rep. Chew (Schmich), and Rep. Roberts requested they be recorded as voting NAY. Rep. Andrus** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
