H 634	BROADBAND - Amends existing law to provide that the State Board of Education shall have certain authority. Senator Semmelroth explained that H 634 changed the State agency that oversaw the Broadband Infrastructure Fund from the Department of Education to the Office of the State Board of Education. She stated that H 634 completed the transition of IT support from the Department of Education to the Office of the State Board of Education and allowed for appropriations.
