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- (2) The state shall not ereate a corporation or act as the incorporator of file, nor cause to be filed on its behalf, and the secretary of state shall not accept, articles of incorporation for any corporation that is provided for in subsection (1) of this section except as expressly authorized by the legislature through the enactment of general laws pursuant to subsection (4) of this section. Provided, however, that the state shall not constitute the voting majority of the board of directors or members of a corporation or its subsidiary. For purposes of this section, "state" means the state of Idaho, a state officer acting in an official capacity, a state employee acting within the scope of employment, or a state agency, department, division, bureau, board commission, or institution.
- (3) A corporation shall not be incorporated by the state The state shall not file, nor cause to be filed on its behalf, articles of incorporation for a corporation to carry out a purpose or function in lieu of the state or to receive or expend appropriated funds in furtherance of such purpose or function.

The language is based on the incorporation code sections in the General Business Corporations Act (Chapter 29, Title 30) and the Nonprofit Corporations Act (Chapter 30, Title 30), which are below.

30-29-203. INCORPORATION. (a) Unless a delayed effective date is specified, the componets existence begins when the articles of incomponetion are filed
