 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 49-666, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 amended to read as follows:

49-666. MOTORCYCLE, MOTORBIKE, UTV AND ATV SAFETY HELMETS -- REQUIRE-9 MENTS AND STANDARDS. No person under eighteen (18) years of age shall ride 10 upon or be permitted to operate a motorcycle, motorbike, utility type vehi-11 12 cle or an all-terrain vehicle unless at all times when so operating or riding upon the vehicle he is wearing, as part of his motorcycle, motorbike, UTV 13 or ATV equipment, a protective safety helmet of a type and quality equal to 14 or better than the standards established for helmets by the director, except 15 the. The provisions of this section shall not apply when such vehicles are 16 operated or ridden on private property $_{\mathcal{T}}$ or when are used as an implement of 17 husbandry, and. The provisions of this section shall also not apply to com-18 pletely enclosed autocycles or to UTVs that are equipped with a roll cage and 19 20 seat belts.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
