## AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1

"33-143. DISPLAY OF FLAGS AND BANNERS ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY. (1)
The purpose of this section is to ensure that flags and banners displayed on
public school property do not promote political, religious, or ideological
viewpoints in order to maintain a neutral and inclusive environment for all
students.

8 (2) No flags or banners that represent political, religious, or ideo9 logical views, including but not limited to political parties, race, gen10 der, sexual orientation, or political ideologies, may be displayed on public

- (a) Official flags or banners representing the United States;

## (f) Achievement flags or banners recognized by the Idaho state department of education;

(4) The Idaho state department of education shall oversee the enforce ment of this section. Schools found in violation of this section shall be re quired to remove unauthorized flags or banners.

(a) "Banner" means a long, rectangular, or square piece of fabric, paper, or other material, often displayed in a vertical or horizontal manner, used to convey a message, symbol, emblem, or representation of an institution or a political, religious, or ideological expression, or used to announce or celebrate an event or achievement.

(b) "Display" means to keep a flag or banner visible on school propertybeyond a brief curriculum-based educational purpose.

(c) "Flag" means a piece of fabric or similar material, typically rect angular or square, attached to a pole or staff and used as a symbol, em blem, or representation of a country, state, tribe, institution, or any
 political, religious, or ideological expression.".
