- 2 RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING CHAPTER 3, TITLE 36, IDAHO CODE, BY THE
 3 ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 36-308, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH A MORATORIUM
 4 ON MULE DEER DOE HUNTING WITHIN CERTAIN MANAGEMENT UNITS AND TO PROVIDE
 5 AN EXCEPTION TO THE MORATORIUM; PROVIDING A SUNSET DATE; AND DECLARING
 6 AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 3, Title 36, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
 9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des 10 ignated as Section 36-308, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

11 36-308. MULE DEER DOE HUNT MORATORIUM. (1) Due to reduced population, 12 low survival rates, and reduced success rates of hunters there shall be a 13 five (5) year moratorium, commencing on July 1, 2025, on all mule deer doe 14 hunts within the following game management units: 19, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 15 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 52A, 53, 54, 55, 56, and 57.

(2) The commission may permit hunting within a unit that has a morato-rium if chronic wasting disease is found within the unit.

18 SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall be null, void, 19 and of no force and effect on and after July 1, 2030.

20 SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 21 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 22 July 1, 2025.
