

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS32237C1 / H0196

The document is a bill draft related to fish and game in Idaho. It establishes a five-year moratorium on mule deer doe hunting in specific game management units with high migratory movement and due to reduced population, low survival rates, and decreased success rates of hunters. The moratorium will start on July 1, 2025, and exceptions may be made if chronic wasting disease is found in a unit. The provisions of the moratorium will be null and void after July 1, 2030.

## FISCAL NOTE

There will be no fiscal impact to state or local governments if this legislation passes because it does not create or expand any programs and does not require the expenditure of any funds.
