Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 67-5292, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 67-5292. PERIODIC REVIEW SUNSET OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES. (1) Each rule chapter that is in effect on July 1, 2026, shall be reviewed by the legislature sunset on a staggered, periodic schedule between July 1, 2026, and June 30, 2034, and on a similar schedule each eight (8) years thereafter. The review sunset schedule shall be established by the office of the administrative rules coordinator, and the schedule shall be posted on its website and on the cover page of each rule chapter no later than January 1, 2026.
- (2) Prior to the review sunset date for each rule chapter, as established in the review schedule pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, if an agency intends to renew such chapter, the promulgating agency shall prepare a report statement for the legislature that states the statute or federal regulation the rule is intended to implement and whether the substantive content in the rule chapter is still necessary, and, if it is determined to be necessary so, the rationale for such determination and any evidence to justify its benefits relative to its costs. In addition, the agency shall report state whether the necessary substantive content would be more appropriately integrated into Idaho Code as opposed to remaining as a separate administrative rule. In consideration of such report statement, the promulgating agency shall consider:
 - (a) The benefit of having all related requirements in a single location in Idaho Code;
 - (b) The frequency with which the substantive content of the administrative rule has been updated in the prior five (5) years and the anticipated frequency of updates in the near future; and
 - (c) The cost of publishing and maintaining the administrative rule in the Idaho administrative code and bulletin—; and

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
