4	TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING EXPIRATION ON RULEMAKING AUTHORITY,
5	AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 52, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 67-5233, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

67-5233. EXPIRATION ON RULEMAKING AUTHORITY. Agencies possessing the statutory authority to promulgate rules that interpret, prescribe, implement, or enforce a statute passed on or after July 1, 2025, shall have ten (10) years to promulgate all necessary rules and regulations related to such statute. After ten (10) years, the agency may only promulgate new rules and regulations related to the relevant statute after a substantive amendment to the section or chapter by the legislature or following the addition of a new statute that confers rulemaking authority, as long as the rulemaking is started within two (2) years of the amendment or new statute.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
