Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 25, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 67-2512, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 67-2512. STATE WEBSITES TO INCLUDE RULE AND POLICY DOCUMENTS. (1) Each department of the state of Idaho identified in section 67-2402(1), Idaho Code, including each division, bureau, section, commission, or other sub-entity of the executive department of state and each constitutional officer identified in section 67-2402(2), Idaho Code, shall, if such department, sub-entity, or officer maintains a website, include on such website any administrative rules or policies promulgated by the department, sub-entity, or officer. The content required to be published pursuant to this section shall be reviewed and updated by each department, sub-entity, or officer at least annually to ensure that it remains current and accurate.
- (2) Each website subject to the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall include the following statement: "Agency policy statements and guidance documents shall not have the force and effect of law pursuant to section 67-5207A, Idaho Code."
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
