4	LISH PROVISIONS PROVIDING FOR POLICIES REGARDING WIRELESS ELECTRONIC
5	COMMUNICATION DEVICES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$, to be known and designated as Section 33-132A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-132A. WIRELESS ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES POLICY REQUIRED. For purposes of this section, "wireless electronic communication device" means any electronic device, including but not limited to a telephone, personal digital assistant, paging device, text-messaging device, or other device with similar functions that can be used to wirelessly communicate with another person. No later than August 1, 2025, each local school district shall adopt a policy that addresses student possession of wireless electronic communication devices as defined in this section. Such policy shall be approved by the school district's board of trustees and shall be included in the school district's written student conduct standards. If the policy provided for in this section includes confiscation of wireless electronic communication devices, it shall also provide for the return of such devices to the students. At a minimum, such policy shall prohibit the use of wireless electronic communication devices in classrooms during periods of academic instruction.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
