SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of Idaho for Health Education Programs is hereby increased by two (2.00) for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

 SECTION 3. PRIORITIZING AND REPORTING ON PROGRESS IN WOMEN'S HEALTH. The Idaho Graduate Medical Education Committee shall immediately prioritize obstetrics and gynecology (OB/GYN) fellowships in its overall preparation and training of family medicine residents. The Idaho Graduate Medical Education Committee shall provide a written report to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee detailing progress towards this goal by October 1, 2025. The format and content of this report will be determined in consultation with the Budget and Policy Analysis Division of the Legislative Services Office.

SECTION 4. CONDITIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND RESTRICTIONS. Appropriations made pursuant to this act are subject to the conditions, limitations, and restrictions specified in this act.

SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
