 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE BOARD  
 3 OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO FOR HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMS;  
 4 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND  
 5 THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO FOR HEALTH EDUCATION  
 6 PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FULL-TIME EQUIV-  
 7 ALENT POSITIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; PRIORITIZING AND REPORTING ON  
 8 PROGRESS IN WOMEN'S HEALTH; PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND  
 9 RESTRICTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
 10 DATE.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

12 SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law,  
 13 there is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education and the Board  
 14 of Regents of the University of Idaho for Health Education Programs, the  
 15 following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and  
 16 expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2025, through  
 17 June 30, 2026:

14 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In addition to any other authorization  
 15 provided by law, the full-time equivalent position authorization provided  
 16 to the State Board of Education and the Board of Regents of the University of  
 17 Idaho for Health Education Programs is hereby increased by two (2.00) for the  
 18 period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.

19 SECTION 3. PRIORITIZING AND REPORTING ON PROGRESS IN WOMEN'S HEALTH.  
 20 The Idaho Graduate Medical Education Committee shall immediately prioritize  
 21 obstetrics and gynecology (OB/GYN) fellowships in its overall preparation  
 22 and training of family medicine residents. The Idaho Graduate Medical Edu-  
 23 cation Committee shall provide a written report to the Joint Finance-Appro-  
 24 priations Committee detailing progress towards this goal by October 1, 2025.  
 25 The format and content of this report will be determined in consultation with  
 26 the Budget and Policy Analysis Division of the Legislative Services Office.

27 SECTION 4. CONDITIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND RESTRICTIONS. Appropriations  
 28 made pursuant to this act are subject to the conditions, limitations, and re-  
 29 strictions specified in this act.

30 SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
 31 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
 32 July 1, 2025.
