Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 65, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 67-6512A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 67-6512A. ENERGY FACILITIES -- CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS REQUIRED. (1) In addition to any other requirements provided by law, each governing board shall require a conditional use permit for the construction of any energy facility as defined in section 67-2352, Idaho Code. Application for such conditional use permit shall be subject to the provisions of section 67-6512, Idaho Code. A condition shall be attached to each permit that requires the energy facility to offer for purchase the electricity generated from the facility first to any electric supplier as defined in section 61-332A, Idaho Code, that furnishes electric service to Idaho consumers before making an offer to any other electric supplier that does not furnish electric service to Idaho consumers. Such electricity shall be offered for purchase to the electric supplier furnishing electric service to Idaho consumers at the market price existing at the time of the offer.
- (2) Any conditional use permit granted for the construction of an energy facility that does not comply with the provisions of this section shall be void.
- (3) The provisions of this section shall be null, void and of no force and effect on and after July 1, 2030.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
