2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING CERTAIN RULES OF THE DIVI-
3 SION OF OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL LICENSES RELATING TO RULES OF THE
4 GENETIC COUNSELORS LICENSING BOARD.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses relating to Rules of the
12 Genetic Counselors Licensing Board are not consistent with legislative in-
13 tent or Idaho's code of ethics and should be rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
15 sion of the Sixty-eighth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
16 the Senate concurring therein, that final rule contained in IDAPA 24.24.01,
17 Section 002., Section II, Item 3. of the incorporated by reference "National
18 Society of Genetic Counselors Code of Ethics," relating to Rules of the
19 Genetic Counselors Licensing Board, Rules of the Division of Occupational
20 and Professional Licenses, only, be, and the same is hereby rejected and
21 declared null, void, and of no force and effect as of July 1, 2025.
