# SENATE BILL NO. 1046, As Amended

### BY EDUCATION COMMITTEE

#### AN ACT

- RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING CHAPTER 16, TITLE 33, IDAHO CODE, BY THE AD-2 DITION OF A NEW SECTION 33-1637, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR HUMAN GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT INSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AND DECLARING AN EMER-4 5 GENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 6

SECTION 1. That Chapter 16, Title 33, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 7 8 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-9 ignated as Section 33-1637, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

33-1637. HUMAN GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT INSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC 10 SCHOOLS. (1) Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, each school district, 11 12 specially chartered district, and public charter school serving students in grades 5 through 12 inclusive, or any combination thereof, shall include 13 instruction on human growth and development as provided in this subsection 14 and subsection (2) of this section. Such instruction shall include but shall 15 not be limited to an age appropriate presentation of: 16

(a) A high-definition ultrasound video, at least three (3) minutes in 17 duration, showing the development of the brain, heart, sex organs, and 18 other vital organs in early fetal development; and 19

(b) A high-quality, computer-generated rendering or animation showing 20 the process of fertilization and every stage of human development in-21 22 side the uterus, noting significant markers in cell growth and organ de-23 velopment for every week of pregnancy until birth.

(2) The instruction required in subsection (1) of this section shall 24 also be included in every class that discusses or provides instruction con-25 cerning human biology, discusses or provides instruction concerning contra-26 ception, or discusses or provides instruction concerning sexually transmit-27 ted diseases or sexually transmitted infections. 28

29 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 30 July 1, 2025. 31
