1 AN ACT 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MILITARY DIVISION; APPROPRIATING ADDI-TIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; REDUCING 3 THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; APPRO-4 5 PRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE STATE EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND TO THE MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE FUND; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO 6 THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 7 2025; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR IT 8 INFRASTRUCTURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING 9 MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE EMERGENCY RE-10 SPONSE FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES. 11

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Military Division the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026:

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other appropriation provided by law to the contrary, the appropriation made to the Military Division is hereby reduced according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026:

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Military Division and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$8,600,000 from the State Emergency Relief Fund to the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026. Such moneys shall be used for hazardous materials regional response.

SECTION 4. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 81, Laws of 2024, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Military Division for the Military Management Program \$540,000 for operating expenditures from the General Fund for the purpose of Public Safety Communications support for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

SECTION 5. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 81, Laws of 2024, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Military Division for the Military Management Program \$759,200 for operating expenditures from the General Fund for the purpose of upgrading the division's IT infrastructure and licensing for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Military Division and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$34,200 from the General Fund to the Hazardous Substance Emergency Response Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. Such moneys shall be used to reimburse costs incurred by the Office of Emergency Management Program in the Military Division pursuant to Section 39-7110, Idaho Code.

SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, Sections 4, 5, and 6 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval, and Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
