SENATE BILL NO. 1130

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MILITARY DIVISION; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE STATE EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND TO THE MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE FUND; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE MILITARY DIVISION FOR IT INFRASTRUCTURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. In addition to any other appropriation provided by law, there is hereby appropriated to the Military Division the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026:

18 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Military Division and
 19 the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$8,600,000 from the State
 20 Emergency Relief Fund to the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund as soon as practica-
 21 ble for the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026. Such moneys shall be
 22 used for hazardous materials regional response.

23 SECTION 4. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
 24 ter 81, Laws of 2024, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
 25 hereby appropriated to the Military Division for the Military Management
 26 Program \$540,000 for operating expenditures from the General Fund for the
 27 purpose of Public Safety Communications support for the period July 1, 2024,
 28 through June 30, 2025.

29 SECTION 5. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
 30 ter 81, Laws of 2024, and any other appropriation provided by law, there is
 31 hereby appropriated to the Military Division for the Military Management
 32 Program \$759,200 for operating expenditures from the General Fund for the
 33 purpose of upgrading the division's IT infrastructure and licensing for the
 34 period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

35 SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Military Division and
 36 the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$34,200 from the General
 37 Fund to the Hazardous Substance Emergency Response Fund as soon as practica-
 38 ble for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. Such moneys shall be
 39 used to reimburse costs incurred by the Office of Emergency Management Pro-
 40 gram in the Military Division pursuant to Section 39-7110, Idaho Code.

1 SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
2 declared to exist, Sections 4, 5, and 6 of this act shall be in full force and
3 effect on and after passage and approval, and Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act
4 shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2025.
