2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE SENATE AND PROVIDING THAT ALL TEMPORARY AND PENDING  
3 RULES OF THE IDAHO STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, THE IDAHO SHEEP  
4 AND GOAT HEALTH BOARD, THE DIVISION OF OCCUPATIONAL AND PROFESSIONAL  
5 LICENSES, AND THE IDAHO OILSEED COMMISSION HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND AP-  
6 PROVED BY THE SENATE AGRICULTURAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE.

7 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Idaho:

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, standing committees  
9 of the Legislature shall review any temporary or pending rule that is ger-  
10 mane to its committee and has been published in the Idaho Administrative Bul-  
11 letin; and

12 WHEREAS, the Senate Agricultural Affairs Committee reviewed temporary  
13 and pending rules adopted by the Idaho State Department of Agriculture, the  
14 Idaho Sheep and Goat Health Board, the Division of Occupational and Profes-  
15 sional Licenses, and the Idaho Oilseed Commission.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Senate, assembled  
17 in the First Regular Session of the Sixty-eighth Idaho Legislature, that all  
18 temporary and pending rules adopted by the Idaho State Department of Agri-  
19 culture, the Idaho Sheep and Goat Health Board, the Division of Occupational  
20 and Professional Licenses, and the Idaho Oilseed Commission, pursuant to the  
21 Administrative Procedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Admin-  
22 istrative Rules Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2025  
23 legislative session have been reviewed and approved by the Senate Agricul-  
24 tural Affairs Committee.
