## A SENATE RESOLUTION

- STATING FINDINGS OF THE SENATE AND PROVIDING THAT ALL TEMPORARY AND PENDING
  RULES OF THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION, THE
  IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE, AND THE DIVISION OF OCCUPATIONAL AND
  PROFESSIONAL LICENSES HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE SENATE
  COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE, WITH EXCEPTIONS.
- 7 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Idaho:

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, standing committees
 9 of the Legislature shall review any temporary or pending rule that is ger 10 mane to its committee and has been published in the Idaho Administrative Bul 11 letin; and

12 WHEREAS, the Senate Commerce and Human Resources Committee reviewed 13 temporary and pending rules adopted by the Idaho Department of Labor, the 14 Industrial Commission, the Idaho Department of Insurance, and the Division 15 of Occupational and Professional Licenses.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Senate, assembled in the First Regular Session of the Sixty-eighth Idaho Legislature, that all 17 temporary and pending rules adopted by the Idaho Department of Labor, the In-18 dustrial Commission, the Idaho Department of Insurance, and the Division of 19 Occupational and Professional Licenses, pursuant to the Administrative Pro-20 cedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Administrative Rules Co-21 ordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2025 legislative session 22 have been reviewed and approved by the Senate Commerce and Human Resources 23 Committee with the following exceptions that were not approved: 24

(1) IDAPA 09.01.35, Idaho Department of Labor, Unemployment Insurance
 Tax Administration Rules, Docket No. 09-0135-2401, Section 011., Subsection 07., only; and

(2) IDAPA 24.37.01, Division of Occupational and Professional
 Licenses, Rules of the Idaho Real Estate Commission, Docket No.
 24-3701-2401, Section 150., Subsection 02.a., only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Commerce and Human Resources Committee held that the following pending rule docket become effective upon sine die of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-eighth Idaho Legislature: IDAPA 24.39.10, Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses, Rules of the Idaho Electrical Board, Docket No. 24-3910-2402.
