1. Background:

The Governor recommended that the College and Universities receive \$900,000 onetime from the General Fund to create an Eastern Idaho Forensic Pathology Center to provide autopsy services for the eastern region of the state.

At present, forensic autopsy services in the State of Idaho require remains to be transported from Eastern Idaho to Ada County, which requires the commitment of personnel and financial resources from the investigating agency. The proposed center in a collaboration between Idaho State University and Bannock County, the latter of whom is providing \$2,000,000 in initial funds for equipment and space renovations. Recommended funds would support personnel and operating costs for the center until such costs could be covered by fees for services.

This motion anticipates reappropriation authority for FY 2023.

2. Reopen FY 2022 Budget:

"I request unanimous consent to reopen the fiscal year 2022 budget for the College and Universities."

3. Appropriation:

"I move for fiscal year 2022, for the Office of the State Board of Education an additional \$900,000 in onetime operating expenditures from the General Fund to create an Eastern Idaho Forensic Pathology Center at Idaho State University."

1. Background:

The Governor recommended that the College and Universities receive \$1,100,000 onetime from the General Fund for start-up costs and building preparation for a nuclear engineering program at Idaho State University (ISU) and the University of Idaho (UI). Of this recommendation, \$550,000 is for ISU and \$550,000 for UI, all from operating expenditures.

This motion anticipates reappropriation authority for FY 2023.

2. Appropriation:

"I move for fiscal year 2022, for the Office of the State Board of Education an additional \$1,100,000 in onetime operating expenditures from the General Fund for a nuclear engineering programming at Idaho State University and University of Idaho."
