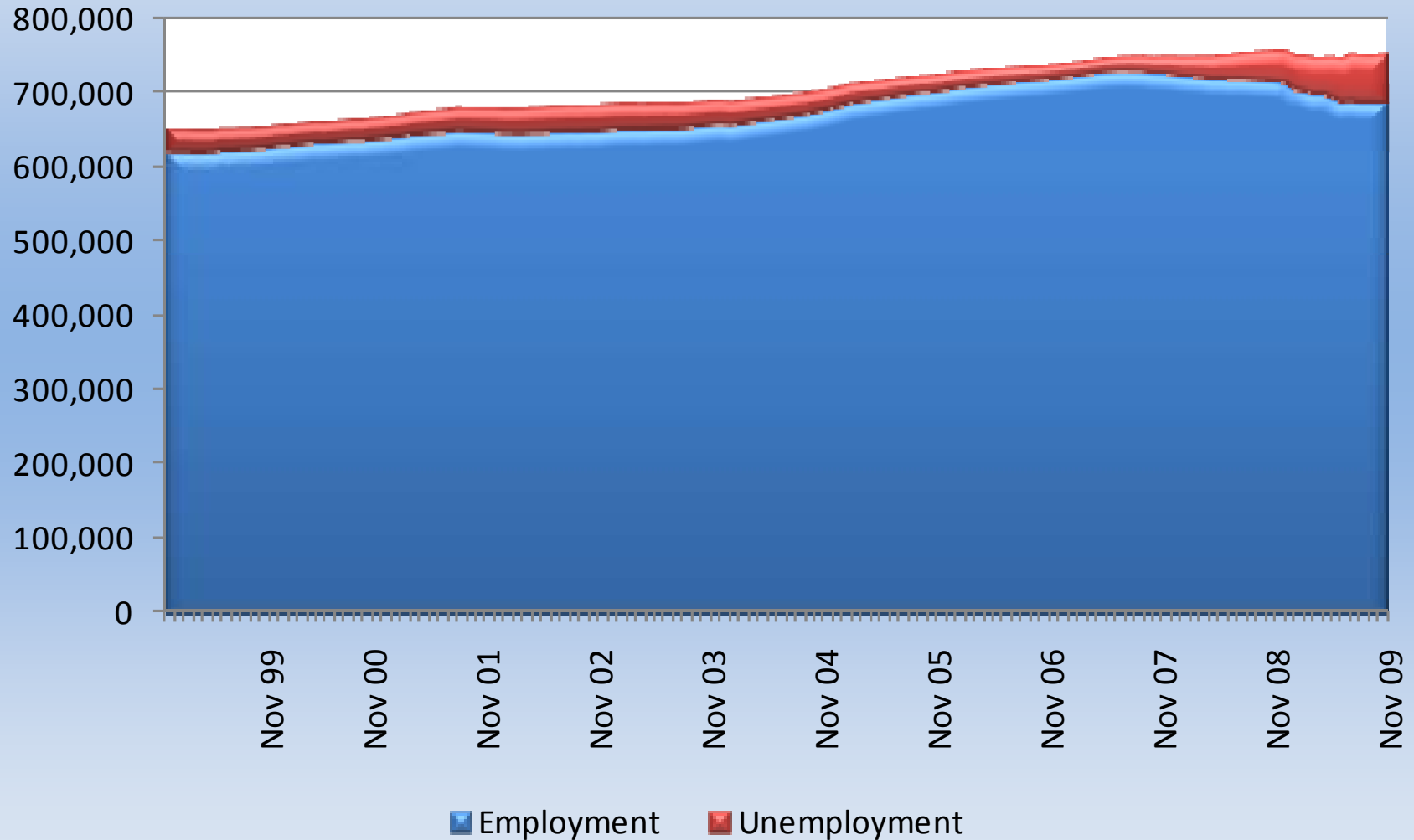

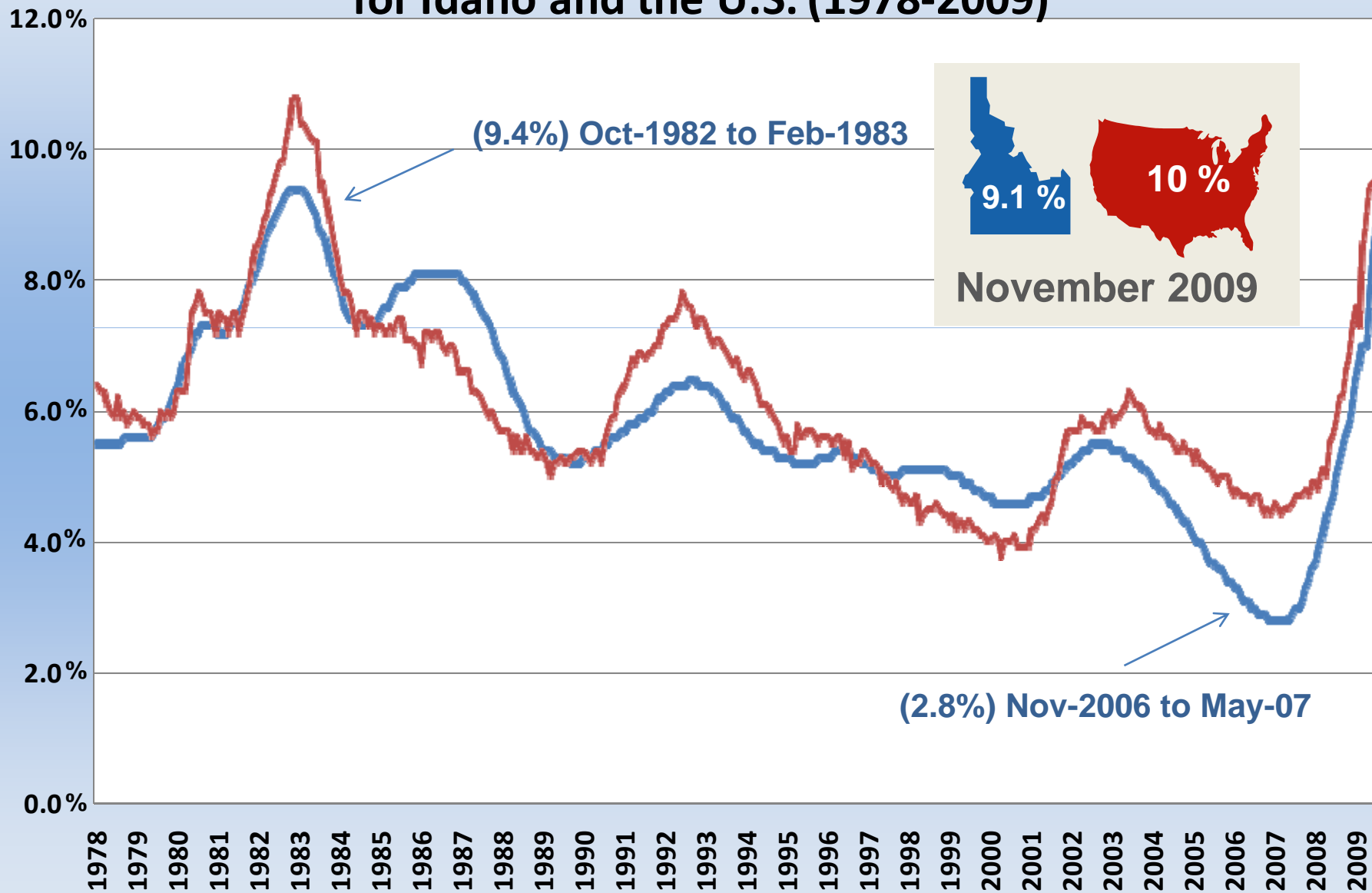

Employment & Unemployment in Idaho's Labor Force, January 1999 to November 2009

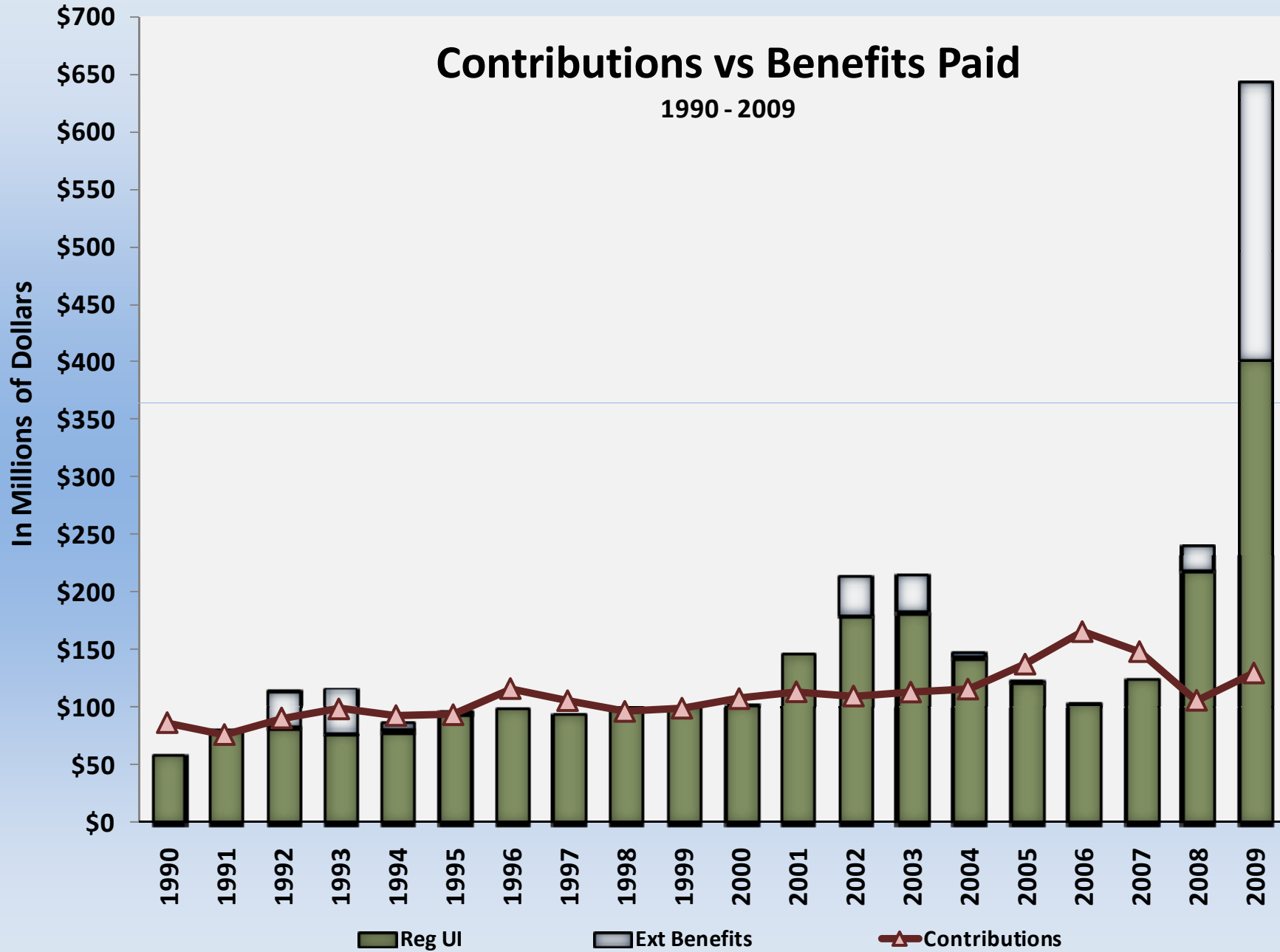


Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate for Idaho and the U.S. (1978-2009)



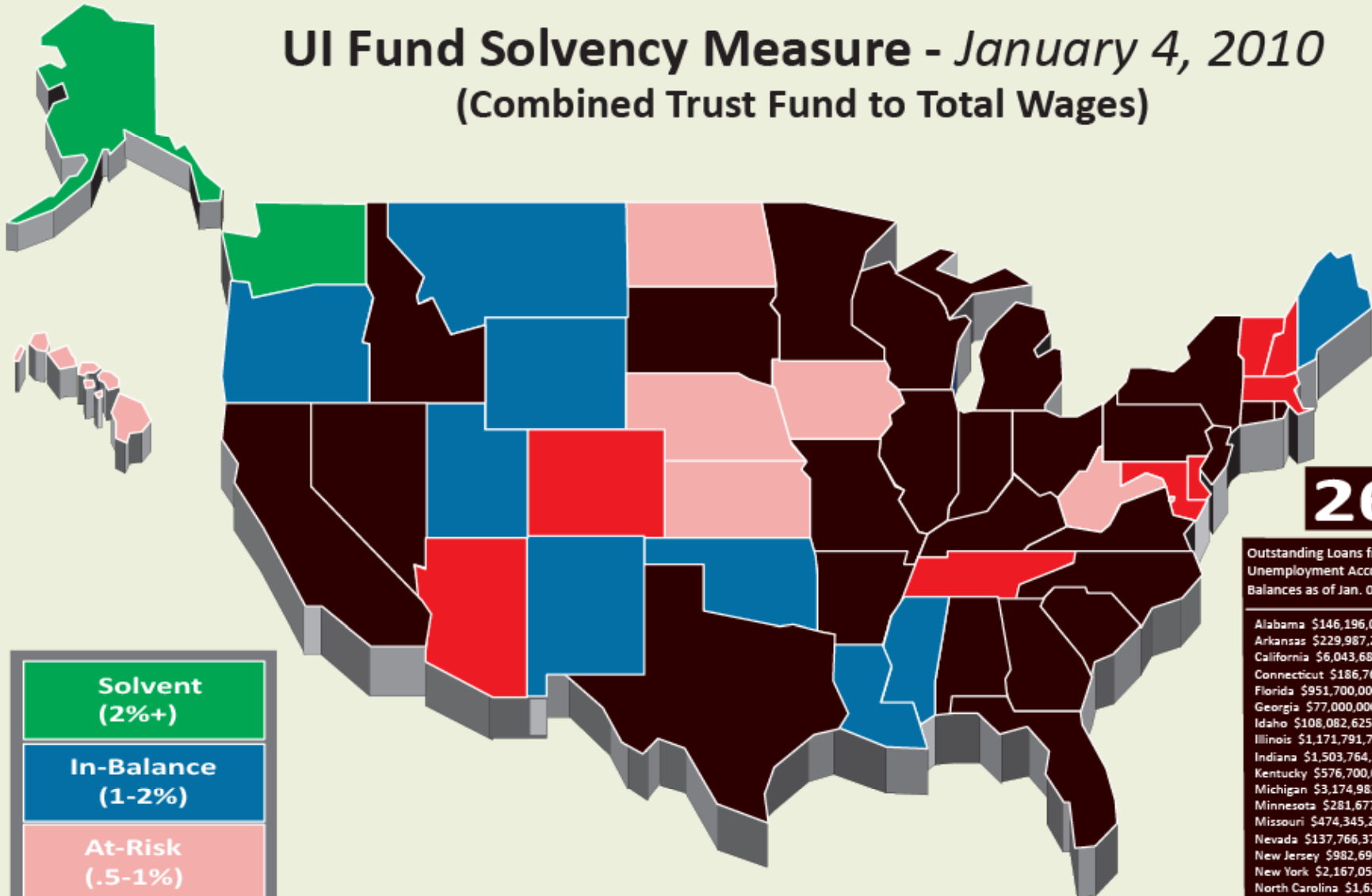
Contributions vs Benefits Paid

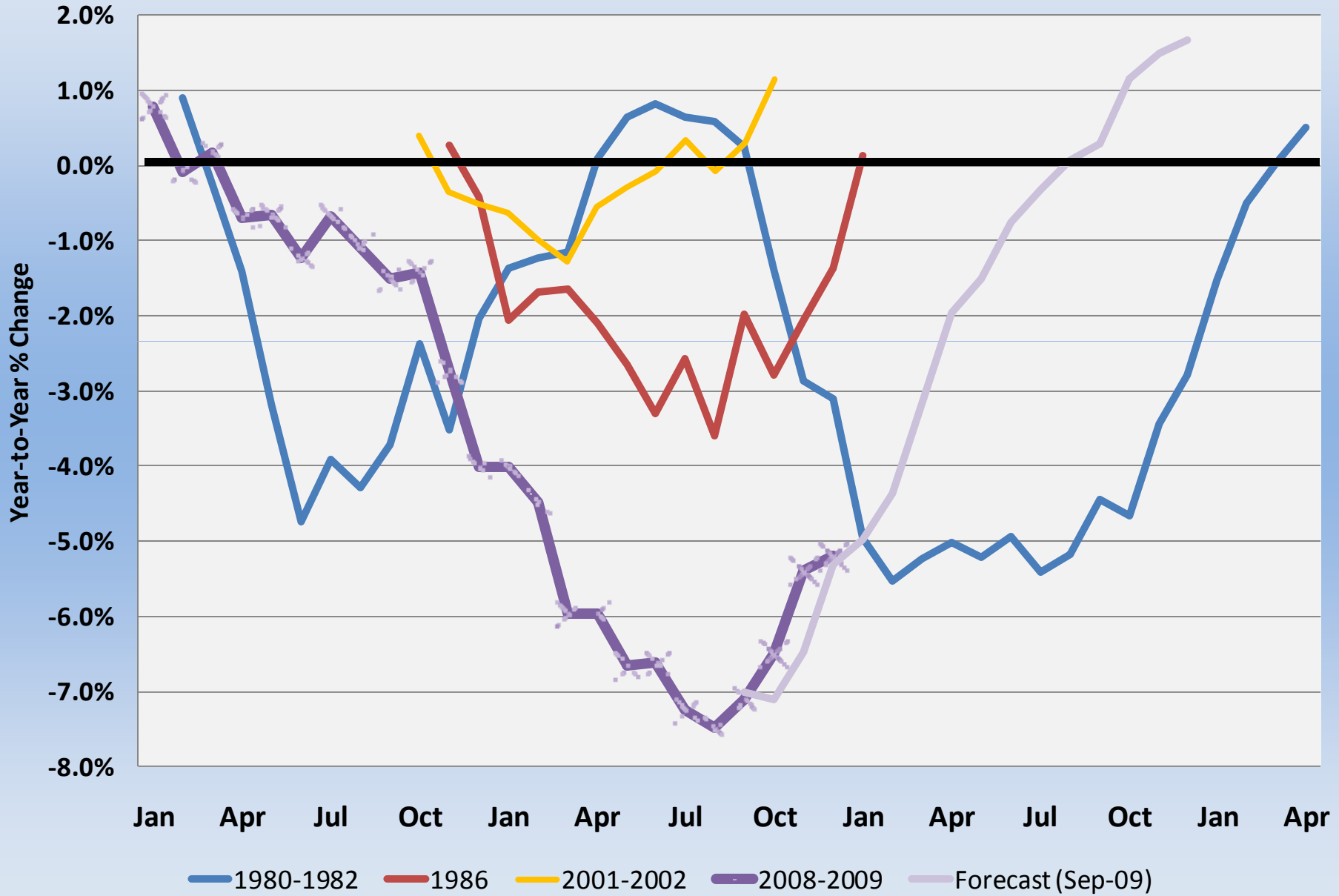

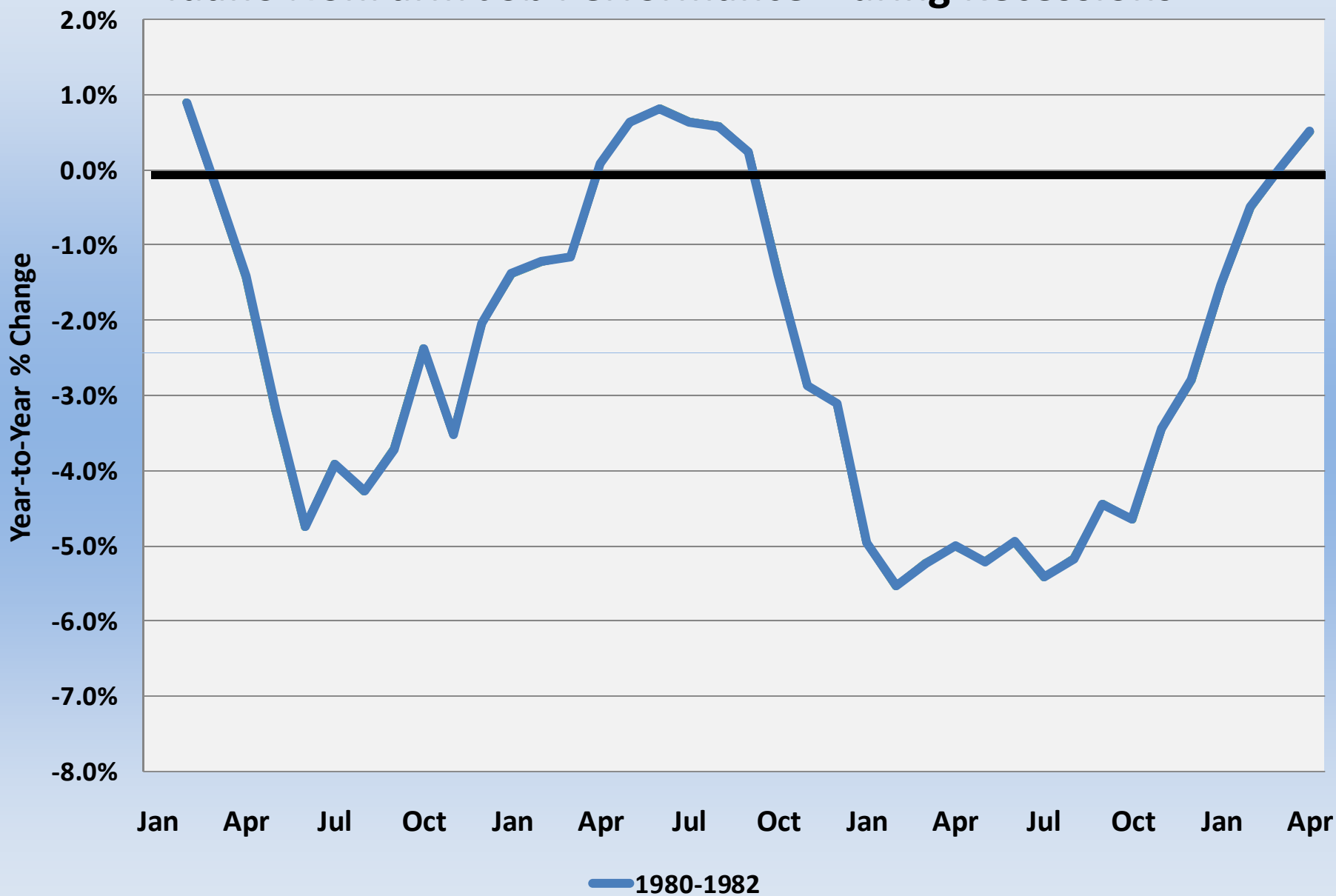

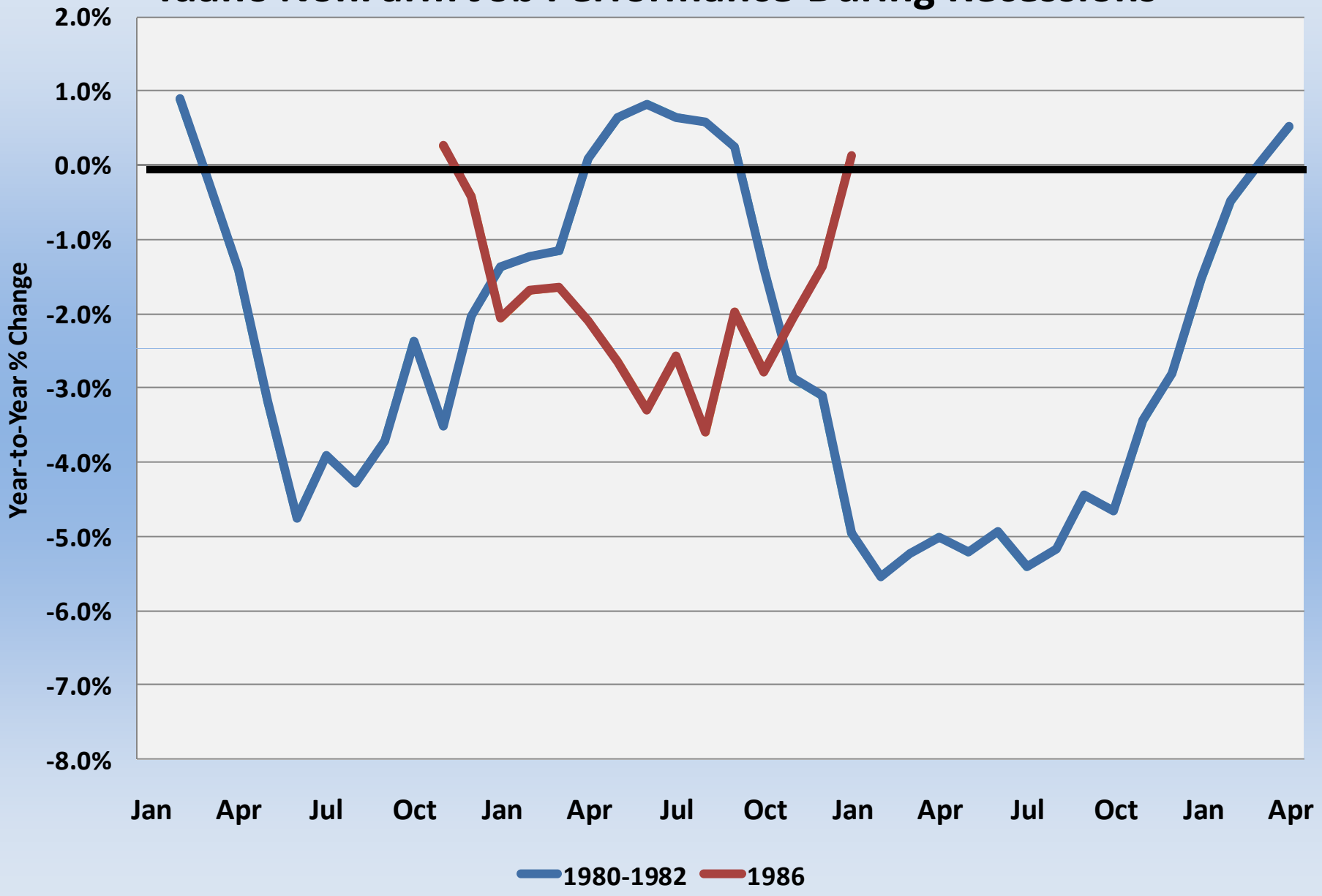
Idaho NonFarm Job Performance During Recessions



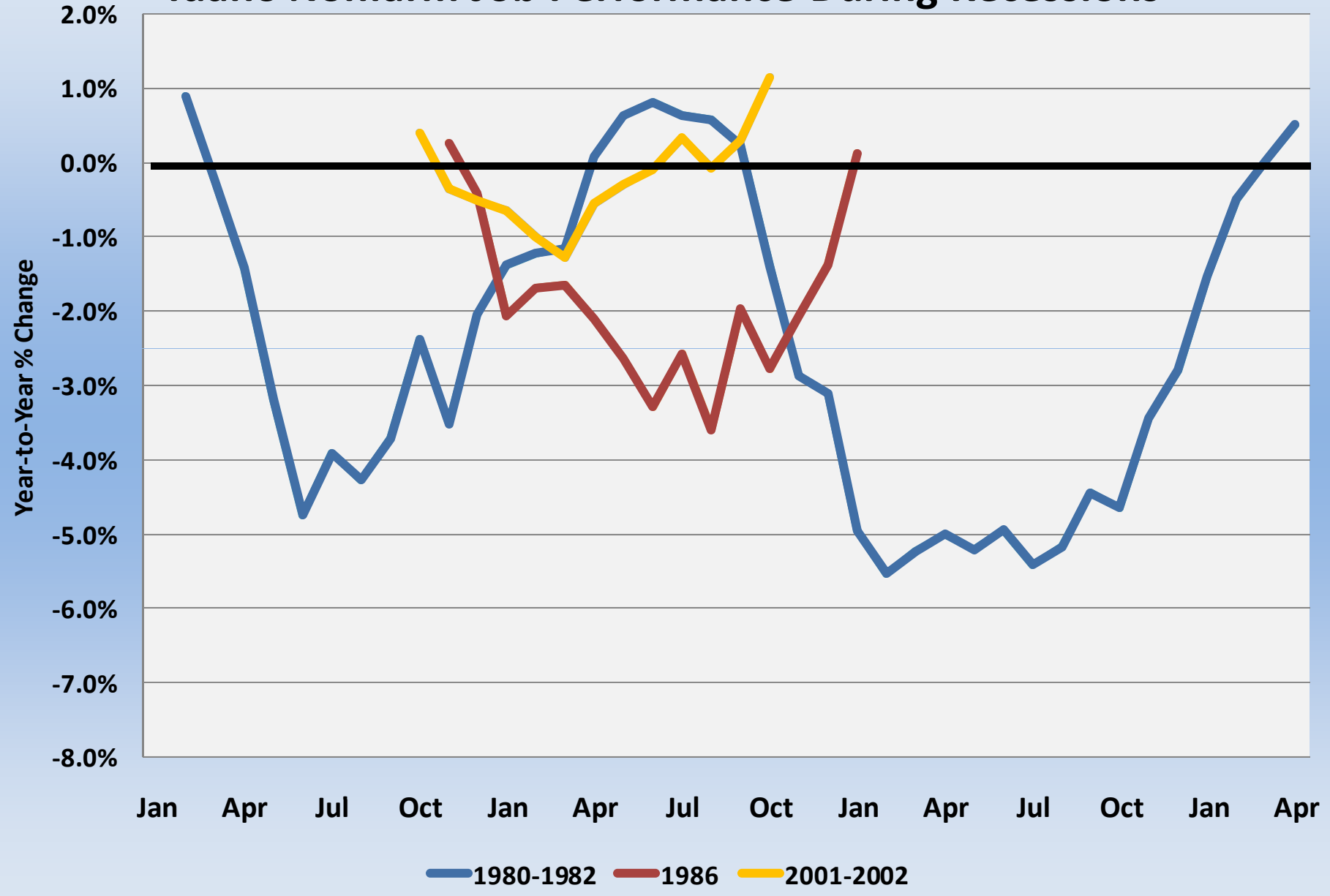

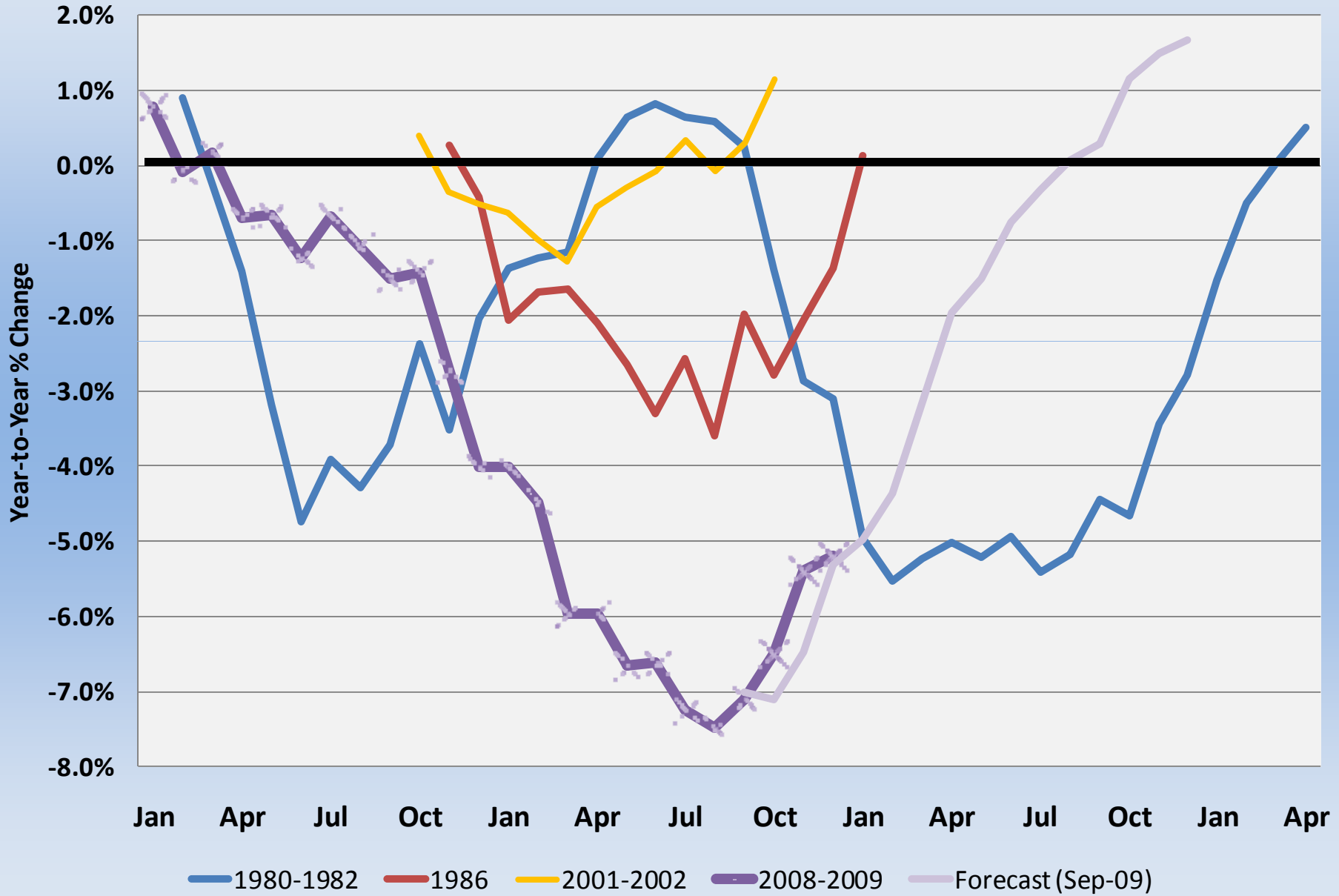

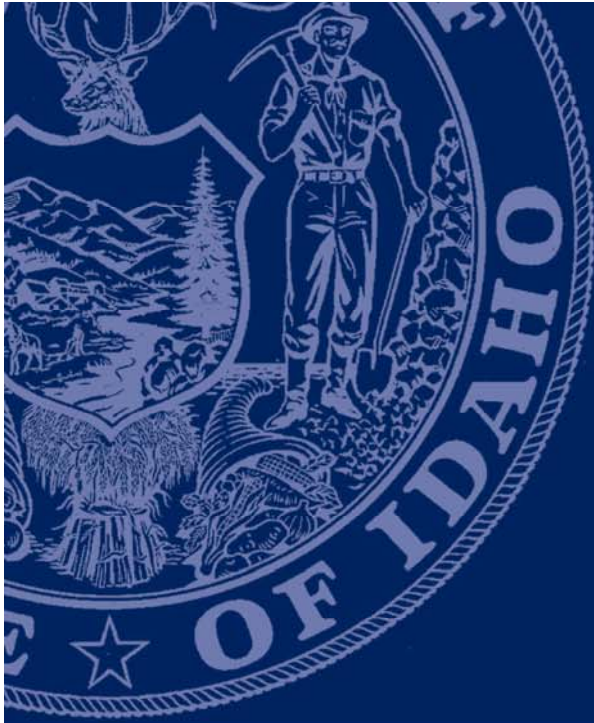


Idaho Nonfarm Job Performance During Recessions

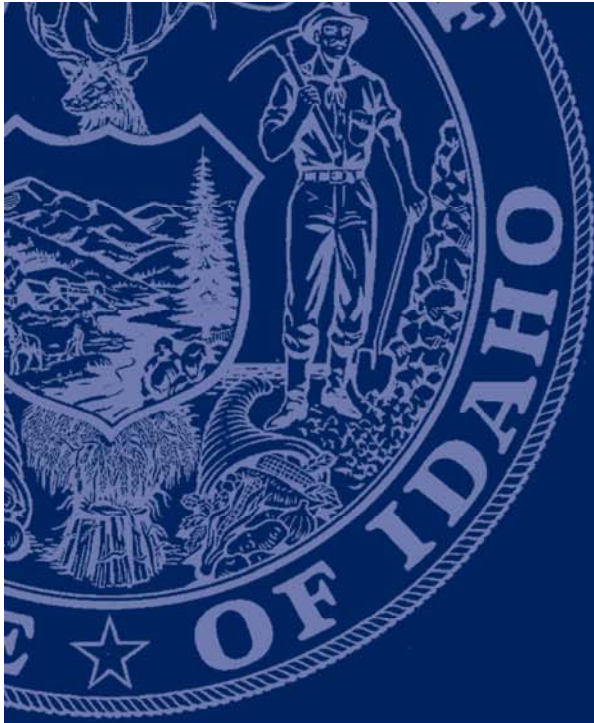
