SUBJECT: Providing Testimony to the Economic Outlook and Revenue Assessment Committee

Thank you for agreeing to appear before the committee to share your knowledge and expertise with us. Enclosed with this memorandum is a DRAFT copy of the committee agenda.

The overriding charge of the committee is to evaluate the reasonableness of the Governor's General Fund revenue forecasts for the current and following fiscal years. A key step in making that evaluation is hearing your expert testimony as we assess the state's overall economy and the revenue streams into the General Fund.
