Senator Goedde

The federal Bureau of Labor Statistics maintains the underemployment figures on by quarter annualized. For the second quarter of 2010 – and the three prior quarters – the unemployment rate was 8.8 percent. Discouraged workers were 0.3 percent and part-time workers wanting full-time jobs were 6.7 percent for a combined rate of 15.8 percent.

Our analysis of underemployment for calendar 2009, which includes not just part-timers who want full-time jobs but people with degrees who are currently working but also looking for other jobs, was 12.7 percent and does not include discouraged workers.

The average labor force for that period was 754,013 so unemployed by BLS figures would have been 66,353 traditional unemployed, 68,615 with discouraged workers and 119,134 with part-timers wanting full-time work.

The 2009 underemployment rate of 12.7 percent equals 95,206.

Senator Bilyeu,

We track characteristics of people registered with the department's employment services once a month during the week of the 12<sup>th</sup>. On Nov. 14, 8,271 of the 95,718 people registered with employment services – both unemployed and employed looking for better jobs – were veterans. That's 8.6 percent. Of the 30,960 active unemployment claims on that date, 3,462, or 11.2 percent, were veterans.
