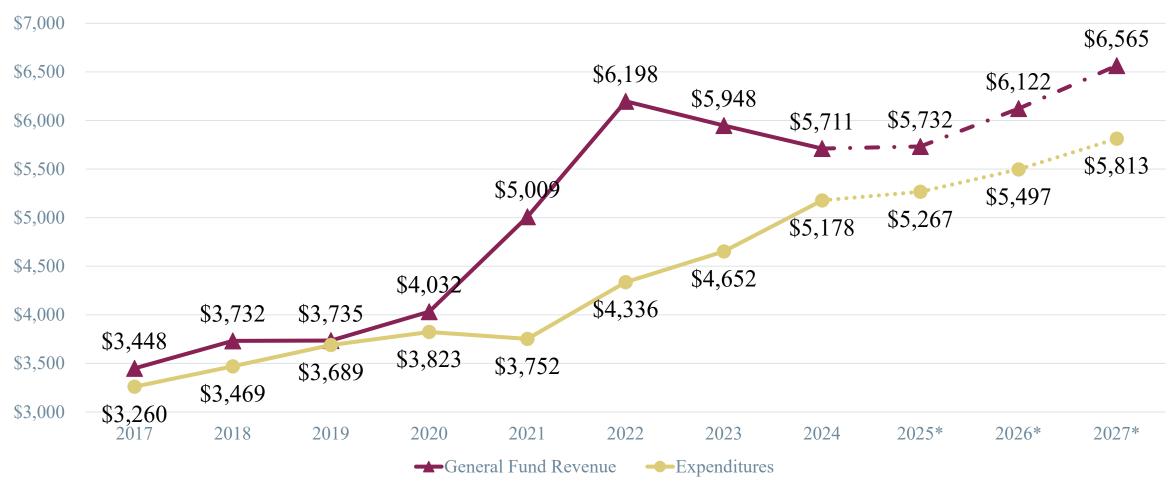

General Fund (in millions)

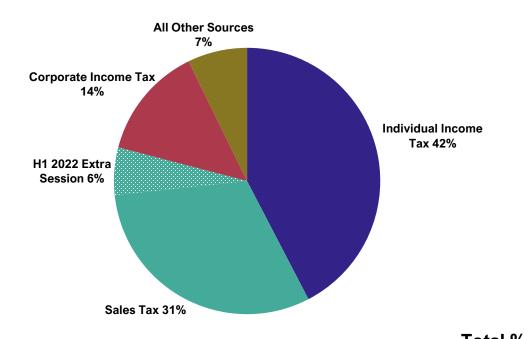




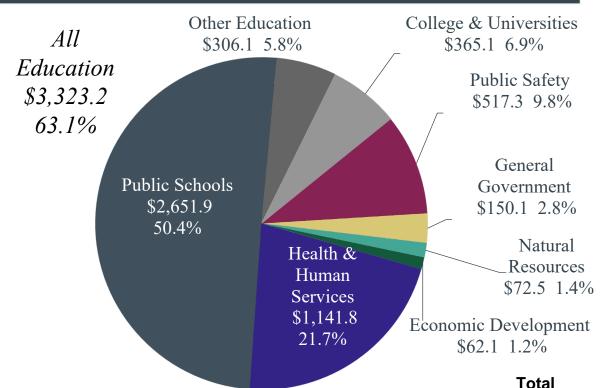

Dollars In Millions (Percent of Revenue)



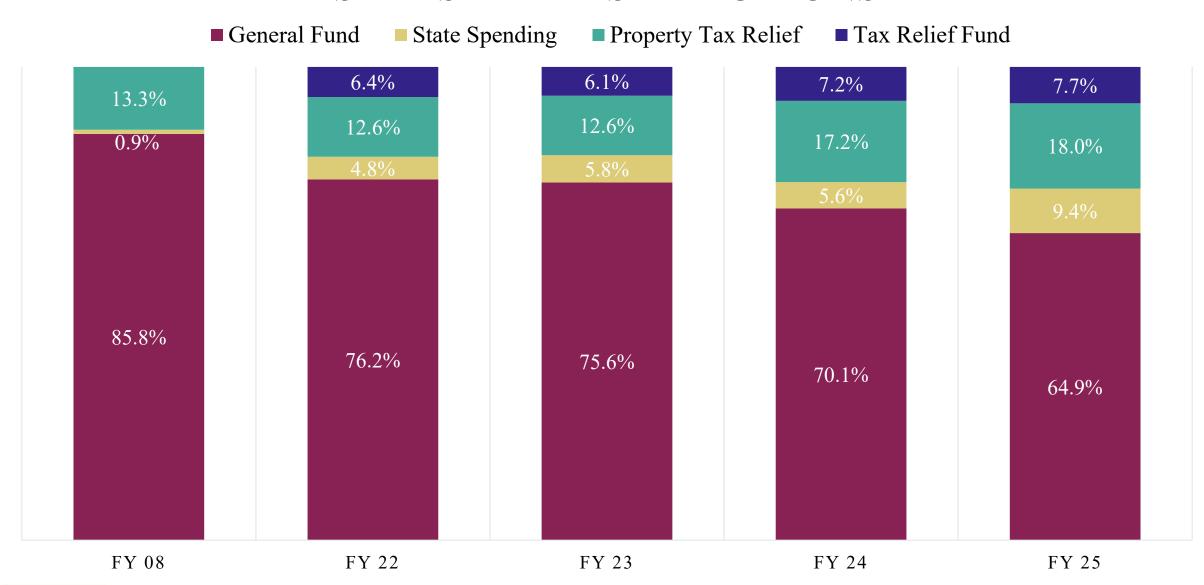

SALES TAX DISTRIBUTIONS





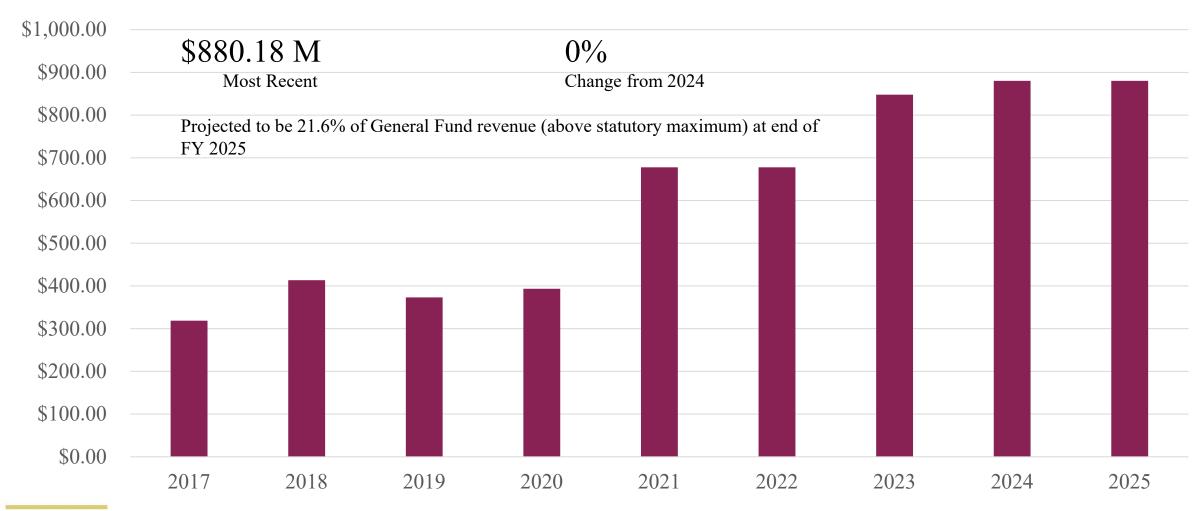

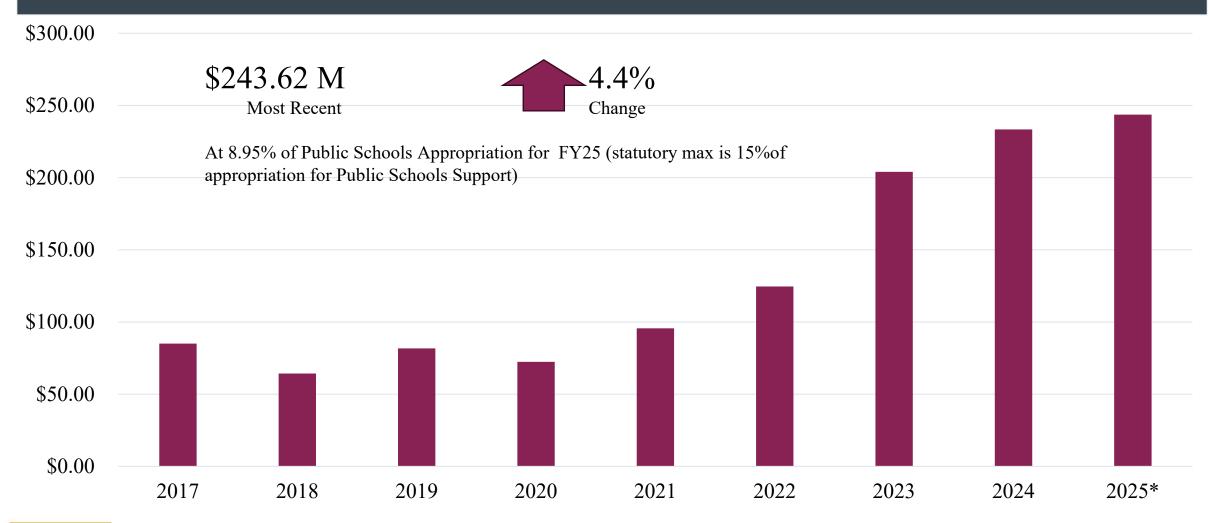


Budget Stabilization Fund (in millions)





Public Education Stabilization Fund(in millions)



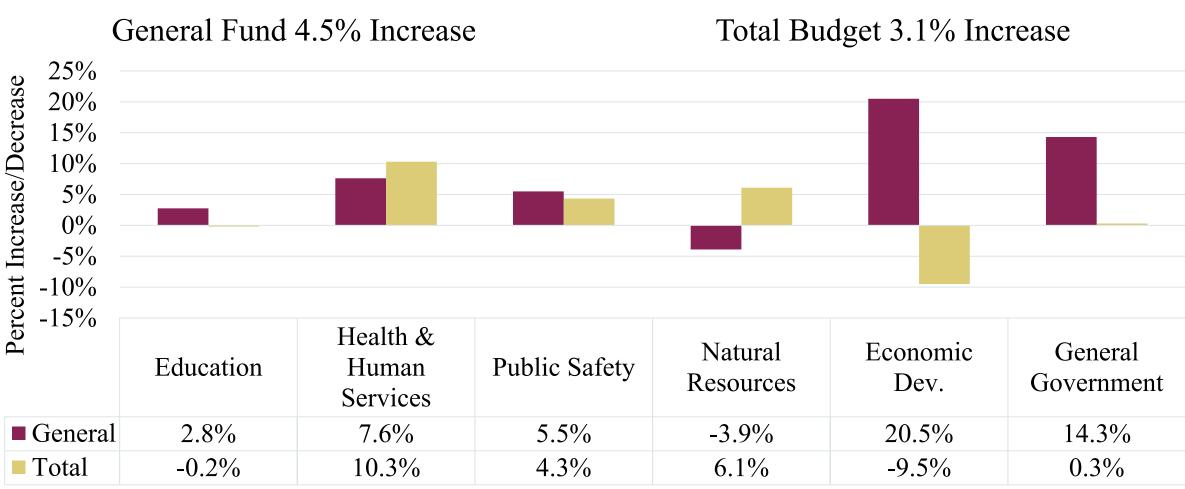
