General Fund Budget Monitor – October 2022

General Fund revenue collections in October totaled \$455.5 million which brings total FY 2023 collections to \$1.791 billion. This cumulative amount is \$133.9 million or 8.1% more than at this point last fiscal year (see page 2 lines 15-16). Compared to last year, individual income tax collections are up \$4.7 million, corporate income tax collections are up \$57.2 million, sales tax collections are up \$82.8 million, while product taxes are \$9.2 million behind and miscellaneous revenues are \$1.6 million less. General Fund revenue collections are nearly on pace with the Division of Financial Management (DFM) revised forecast and are short by only \$1.5 million. This month's budget monitor is projecting a larger ending balance than last month's because individual income tax collections are back on forecast. With revenue collections running \$1.5 million behind projections on line 8, and assuming the rest of the revenue forecast comes in as predicted, total revenues available for FY 2023 are \$5.97 billion (line 9). Using the budget that was set last March as found on lines 11 through 15, the projected ending balance is \$1.56 billion (line 16).


