General Fund Budget Monitor – March 2023

The Legislature adjourned Sine Die on Thursday, April 6, 2023, with an estimated ending cash balance of \$416.4 million (line 16). To achieve this large ending balance, the Legislature approved a total reduction of \$41.6 million in current year supplementals, also known as mid-year budget adjustments from original appropriations, with savings primarily from Medicaid (line 14). Additionally, the Legislature transferred \$133.4 million less to other funds than was recommended by the Governor with totals reflected in line 10. Line 10 includes \$627.9 million for transfers to other funds approved in the 2022 legislative session, and just over \$1 billion approved this legislative session for water projects, maintenance of state facilities, airports, bridges, and state parks. To further address the state's record budget surplus, and provide fiscal relief to Idahoans, the Legislature provided \$76.6 million of onetime property tax relief beginning in FY 2023 with passage of H292 (line 5), the ongoing property tax relief begins in FY 2024. Column 1 in the table below reflects action taken by the 2022 Legislature through Sine Die of 2023, which creates the final budget for FY 2023. The "update" column reflects revenue changes since the 2023 Sine Die. Switching to revenues, General Fund collections in March totaled \$342.3 million, bringing the total FY 2023 collections to \$3.9 billion, which is \$22.2 million more than at this point last year. While the current revenue collections are \$32.6 million below the DFM revised forecast (line 7), the current revenue picture is sufficient to meet budget obligations as set by the Legislature. 
