Public Meeting
Wednesday, October 12, 2011
Capitol Building, Senate Majority Caucus Room
9:30 a.m.

Present were **Commissioner Martinez**, **Commissioner Grange**, **Commissioner Beitelspacher**, **Commissioner Hansen**, and **Commissioner Crow**. Present from the staff were **Mr. Cutler**, **Ms. Ford**, and **Ms. Gaudet**.

Chairman Crow called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m., and asked that the minutes reflect that all of the commissioners, except **Commissioner Olsen**, were present. She said that for general information they were going to do much as they had the day before, by breaking into their individual groups to work. Then they would get back with each other at lunch time for a break, and she also urged the commissioners to take a break in the morning.

Chairman Crow asked if there was anything further that they needed to talk about, any questions, or information. **Commissioner Grange** indicated that someone had come in and left written testimony, which **Ms. Gaudet** had. **Ms. Gaudet** indicated that she would make copies of it for all of the commissioners. **Commissioner Crow** then put the commission at ease subject to call of the chair.

Chairman Crow called the commission back to order at 3:25p.m. She indicated that they had been faced with a glitch in the computer which could not be taken care of until the afternoon of the following day, so it would be her thought that they should adjourn, and meet again that Friday morning. **Commissioner Beitelspacher** moved that they adjourn and meet again on Friday, and **Commissioner Hansen** seconded the motion. **Commissioner Beitelspacher** asked to call for the question, and **Chairman Crow** said that the motion was to meet Friday, October 14th at 9:30 a.m. in the same location. As all were in favor, the motion carried, and the commission was adjourned.

Chairman Crow called the meeting back to order at 3:30 p.m., and said that it was necessary to reconvene because they had received great news that the computer glitch had been taken care of so that they could work the following day. **Commissioner Martinez** moved that they meet as a commission the following day; Thursday at 9:30 a.m. **Commissioner Olsen** seconded the motion. As all agreed, the motion carried.

Commissioner Beitelspacher moved that they adjourn, seconded by **Commissioner Martinez**. **Chairman Crow** adjourned the commission at 3:33 p.m.
