

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

### RS18531C1

The law enforcement account (ISP) currently receives 5% of the funding from the Highway Distribution Account. This legislation will amend Section 40-701, Idaho Code, to shift an amount equivalent to the (5%) of the Highway District Account (HDA) to the General Fund over a period of five (5) years. This shift will be accomplished by reducing the percent distribution to ISP by one percent (1%) a year starting in FY 2010. Concurrently, the percent distribution going to the State Highway Account (SHA) will increase by one percent (1%) a year until FY 2014 at which point the percent distribution to the SHA will be sixty-two percent (62%). The distribution to local jurisdictions will remain at thirty-eight percent (38%). Total shift of \$16.9 million over five years.
