SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.B. NO. 258

AMENDMENT TO THE BILL

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 9 through 38; and delete page 2, and insert:
2 "SECTION 1. That Section 54-5003, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to
3 read as follows:

5 54-5003. DEFINITIONS. As used in this chapter:

6 (1) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC)" means and includes the business,
7 trade, practice or work, materials and fixtures used in the design, construction, installation,
8 improvement, extension and alteration of all piping, venting, ductwork, appliances and appurte-
9 nances in connection with any heating, ventilation or air conditioning system or subsystems of
10 such.

11 (2) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning apprentice" means any person who, as his
12 principal occupation, is engaged in learning and assisting in installation, improvement, exten-
13 sion, alteration or repair of HVAC systems. An apprentice shall perform HVAC work under the
14 supervision of an HVAC journeyman or HVAC contractor.

15 (3) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning contractor" means any person who fab-
16 ricates, installs, maintains, services and repairs warm air heating and water heating systems,
17 heat pumps, complete with warm air appliances including, but not limited to, boilers, pool
18 heaters, space heaters, decorative gas and solid-fuel burning furnaces, and gas, propane, elec-
19 tric or oil-fired water heaters; ventilating systems complete with blowers and plenum chambers;
20 air conditioning systems complete with air conditioning unit and the ducts, registers, flues,
21 humidity and thermostatic controls of air, liquid or gas temperatures below fifty (50) degrees
22 fahrenheit or ten (10) degrees celsius, and air filters in connection with any of these systems.

23 (4) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning journeyman" means any person who, as his
24 principal occupation, is engaged in the installation, improvement, extension, alteration or repair
25 of HVAC systems and who is familiar with the provisions of this chapter and who works in the
26 employ and under direction of an HVAC contractor.

27 (5) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning specialty apprentice including specialty
28 limited heating apprentice" means any person who, as his principal occupation, is engaged in
29 learning and assisting in a specific aspect of installation, improvement, extension, alteration
30 or repair of HVAC systems that includes, but is not limited to, such aspects as gas piping,
31 gas appliances and installation, or decorative gas-fired appliances. A specialty apprentice shall
32 perform HVAC work under the supervision of an HVAC journeyman, HVAC specialty journey-
33 man, HVAC contractor or an HVAC specialty contractor.

34 (6) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning specialty contractor including specialty lim-
35 ited heating contractor" means any person who, as his principal occupation, is engaged in a
36 specific aspect of the heating, ventilation and air conditioning trade that includes, but is not

1 limited to, such aspects as gas piping, gas appliances and installation, or decorative gas-fired
2 appliances.

3 (7) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning specialty journeyman including specialty
4 limited heating journeyman" means any person who, as his principal occupation, is engaged
5 in a specific aspect of installation, improvement, extension, alteration or repairing of HVAC
6 systems that includes, but is not limited to, such aspects as gas piping, gas appliances and
7 installation, or decorative gas-fired appliances. A specialty journeyman is familiar with the
8 provisions of this chapter and works in the employ and under direction of an HVAC contractor
9 or an HVAC specialty contractor.

10 (8) "Heating, ventilation and air conditioning system" means any heating, ventilation
11 or air conditioning system in a residential, private, public or semipublic building or structure
12 including, but not limited to, any mechanical means of heating or air conditioning and to gas
13 piping, venting, ductwork and controls.

14 (9) "Local government" means any incorporated city or any county in the state.

15 (10) "Specialty limited heating" as it applies to the definitions of "heating, ventilation
16 and air conditioning specialty apprentice," "heating, ventilation and air conditioning specialty
17 contractor" and "heating, ventilation and air conditioning specialty journeyman" means any per-
18 son who installs, maintains, services and repairs LP gas-fired appliances, LP fuel gas piping
19 and related exhaust venting. This definition of specialty limited heating shall exclude boilers,
20 hydronic systems, ducted forced air systems, ventilating and air conditioning systems, systems
21 with a BTU input rating over three hundred thousand (300,000), solid fuel and electric fu-
22 eled systems. A "specialty limited heating journeyman" is required to meet the experience
23 requirement and either the education or examination requirement set forth in this section to re-
24 ceive a certificate of competency. The education of a "specialty limited heating journeyman"
25 shall include one hundred twenty (120) hours of instruction approved by the board of pro-
26 fessional-technical education in LP gas specialty education. The experience requirement of a
27 "specialty limited heating journeyman" shall be two (2) years' experience working in the trade,
28 in compliance with the requirements of the state in which the applicant received his supervision
29 or as a registered HVAC apprentice or registered HVAC specialty apprentice making HVAC in-
30 stallation on the job under the supervision of a qualified HVAC journeyman or qualified HVAC
31 specialty journeyman. The examination required in this section shall be developed by the board
32 of professional-technical education and approved by the Idaho heating, ventilation and air con-
33 ditioning board."
