1 RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES OFFICE; AMENDING SECTION 67-704,
2 IDAHO CODE, AS ENACTED BY SECTION 11, SENATE BILL NO. 1043, FIRST
3 REGULAR SESSION, SIXTIETH IDAHO LEGISLATURE, TO REVISE DUTIES
4 OF THE RESEARCH AND LEGISLATION FUNCTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE
5 SERVICES OFFICE.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 67-704, Idaho Code, as enacted by Section 11, Senate Bill No.
9 1043, First Regular Session, Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, be, and the same is hereby amended to
10 read as follows:

11 67-704. RESEARCH AND LEGISLATION – FUNCTION OF LEGISLATIVE
12 SERVICES OFFICE. (1) The legislative services office at the direction of the legislative
13 council shall have authority to prepare or assist in the preparation or amendment of legislative
14 bills at the request of any committee or member of the senate or house of representatives.
15 ~~From August 1 until December 1 of each year, u~~Upon request from the governor, lieutenant
16 governor, attorney general, state controller, secretary of state, superintendent of public
17 instruction or state treasurer, the legislative services office at the direction of the legislative
18 council shall have authority to prepare legislative bills for such constitutional officer.

19 (2) In administering this section the legislative services office shall establish and
20 maintain a legislative reference library.

21 (3) The legislative services office shall review and analyze administrative rules in
22 accordance with section 67-454, Idaho Code, and perform other duties as required by the
23 legislative council.

24 (4) The legislative services office is directed to furnish such secretarial and other
25 staff assistance as the citizens' committee on legislative compensation and the redistricting
26 commission may require in the performance of their duties.
