

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS19084

This is a trailer appropriation to House Bill 213. This trailer appropriates \$1,580,000 for fiscal years 2009 and 2010 to the Department of Parks and Recreation. Of the amount, \$65,000 for costs associated with programming while the remaining will pass through to the Department of Agriculture. This bill also appropriates \$1,515,000 to the Department of Agriculture for fiscal years 2009 and 2010 for costs associated with implementing Section 22-1911, Idaho Code. This appropriation is made from the Invasive Species Fund and will support activities related to the prevention, detection, control and management of zebra and quagga mussels.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill appropriates \$1,580,000 to the Department of Parks and Recreation for fiscal years 2009 and 2010. Of the \$1,580,000, \$65,000 is for costs associated with programming, ordering stickers and overall administration of this new fee associated with House Bill 213. The remaining \$1,515,000 will pass through to the Department of Agriculture for implementation of House Bill 213.

This bill also appropriates \$1,515,000 to the Department of Agriculture for the Invasive Species Fund to support activities related to the prevention, detection, control and management of zebra and quagga mussels pursuant to Section 22-1911, Idaho Code. This appropriation is made for fiscal years 2009 and 2010.
