

## **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

### **RS18333**

This concurrent resolution provides for the printing of the Session Laws for the House and Senate for the next two regular sessions. The resolution identifies the two parties who enter into the contract: the Joint Printing Committee and The Caxton Printers. The resolution also refers to the print requirements and price specified in the vendor's price quote, and the section of Idaho code that provides for the printing.

The resolution allows that the number of copies of the Session Laws be determined at the time of the order, and can be adjusted each year according to the demand at that time. The cost for printing the Session Laws for the next two regular sessions is estimated to decrease slightly from last session. The price for printing the volumes has remained the same, but the number of books ordered is decreasing each year. The final cost is based on a price per page, and the price per page decreases as the number of books ordered decreases. The total number of pages printed cannot be determined until the final print draft is completed. Each year only one price quote is received because The Caxton Printers is the only local print company that has the capability of producing the hard-bound copies.

### **FISCAL NOTE**

The approximate estimate for printing the Session Laws for 2009 and 2010 is \$33,000 per year from the Legislative Fund.
