AN ACT

1 RELATING TO WORKER'S COMPENSATION; AMENDING SECTION 72-802, IDAHO
2 CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT WORKER'S COMPENSATION BENEFITS PAYABLE
3 TO A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE UNDER THE WORKER'S COMPENSATION
4 LAWS OF ANY OTHER STATE SHALL NOT BE ASSIGNABLE AND SHALL BE
5 EXEMPT FROM EXECUTION WITH EXCEPTIONS.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 72-802, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to
9 read as follows:

10 72-802. COMPENSATION NOT ASSIGNABLE - EXEMPT FROM
11 EXECUTION. No claims for compensation under this law, including compensation payable
12 to a resident of this state under the worker's compensation laws of any other state, shall be
13 assignable, and all compensation and claims therefor shall be exempt from all claims of
14 creditors, except the restrictions under this section shall not apply to enforcement of an order
15 of any court for the support of any person by execution, garnishment or wage withholding
16 under chapter 12, title 7, Idaho Code.
