HOUSE BILL NO. 418

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR FISCAL  
2 YEAR 2010; AMENDING CHAPTER 205, LAWS OF 2009, BY THE ADDITION OF NEW  
3 SECTIONS TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS' RENT; REAPPROPRIAT-  
4 ING CERTAIN UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED BALANCES FROM THE PERMANENT  
5 BUILDING FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING RETROACTIVE  
6 APPLICATION.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 205, Laws of 2009, be, and the same is hereby  
10 amended by the addition thereto of NEW SECTIONS, to be known and designated  
11 as Sections 6, 7 and 8, Chapter 205, Laws of 2009, and to read as follows:

12 SECTION 6. The State Controller is hereby directed to transfer on July  
13 1, 2009, or as soon thereafter as practicable, \$915,000 from the Permanent  
14 Building Fund to the Administration and Accounting Services Fund/Facilities  
15 Services for statewide elected officials' rent.

16 SECTION 7. The State Controller is hereby directed to transfer on Jan-  
17 uary 1, 2010, or as soon thereafter as practicable, \$915,000 from the Per-  
18 manent Building Fund to the Administration and Accounting Services Fund/Fa-  
19 cilities Services for statewide elected officials' rent.

20 SECTION 8. There is hereby reappropriated to the Department of Admin-  
21 istration, the sum of \$59,000 from the Permanent Building Fund appropriated  
22 for Public Works for Capitol restoration and renovation, which is the un-  
23 expended and unencumbered balance of moneys as provided in Sections 4 and  
24 6, Chapter 455, Laws of 2006, and Section 1, Chapter 333, Laws of 2007, to  
25 be used for Capitol restoration and renovation for the period July 1, 2009,  
26 through June 30, 2010.

27 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
28 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its  
29 passage and approval, and retroactively to July 1, 2009.
