

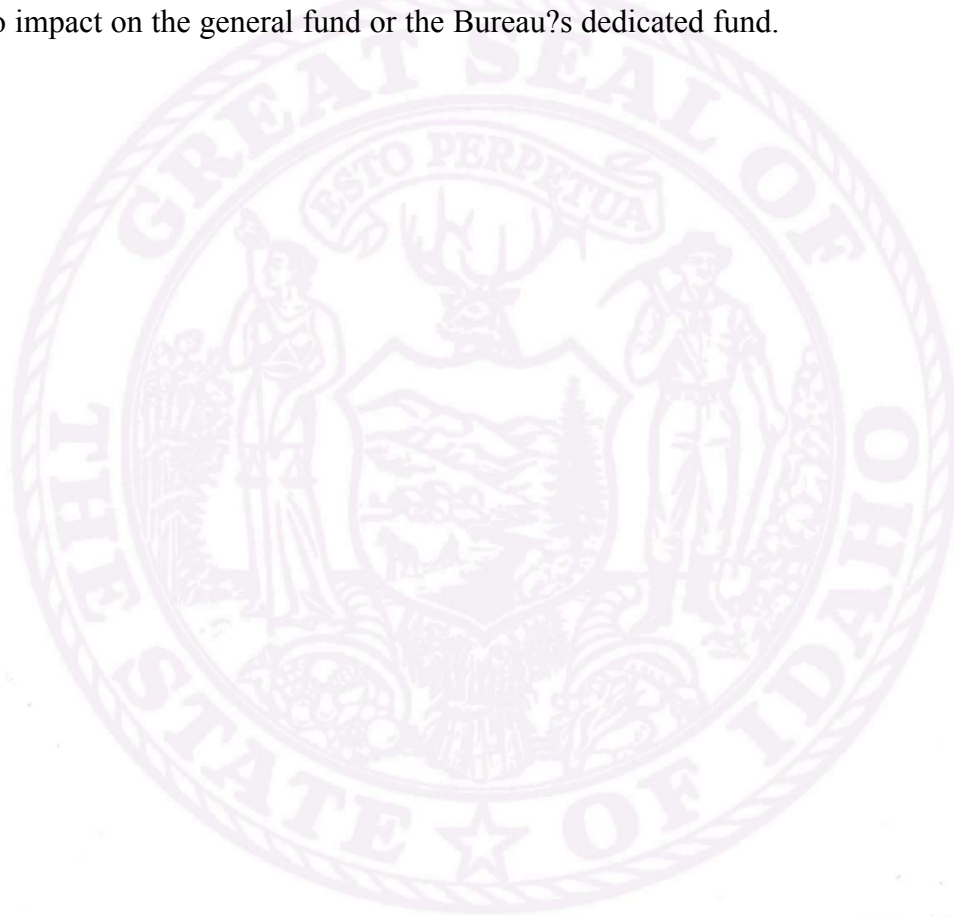
## **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

### **RS19164**

The Board of Physical Therapy is amending section 54-2212 to require that foreign educated physical therapists pass a standardized English proficiency exam to qualify for a license if English is not the applicant's native language. It also clarifies that more than a single competency exam may be required for a license.

### **FISCAL NOTE**

There is no impact on the general fund or the Bureau's dedicated fund.
