HOUSE BILL NO. 639

BY EDUCATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO DRIVER'S EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 33-1706, IDAHO CODE,  
2 TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO A REPORT; AND AMENDING SECTION  
3 33-1707, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
4 SHALL COMPUTE THE NUMBER OF PUPILS COMPLETING A COURSE AND TO REVISE  
5 PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE AMOUNT DUE THE DISTRICT FROM THE DRIVER  
6 TRAINING FUND.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 33-1706, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
10 amended to read as follows:

11 33-1706. REPORTS TO STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. Each school  
12 district which has completed a course or courses in driver training, whether  
13 approved for reimbursement or not, shall submit a report to the state  
14 department of education not later than forty-five (45) days after completion  
15 of the course or courses, showing ~~(1) the number of pupils who enrolled,~~  
16 ~~(2) the number of pupils who completed the course, and (3) the total cost of~~  
17 ~~operation of the program,~~ together with such other information as the state  
18 board may require. Failure to submit reports to the state department of  
19 education shall be cause for the state department of education to disallow  
20 reimbursement even for prior approved driver training program.

21 SECTION 2. That Section 33-1707, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
22 amended to read as follows:

23 33-1707. REIMBURSEMENT -- DETERMINATION -- CERTIFICATION. a. From  
24 the data provided by the school district, as required by section 33-1706,  
25 Idaho Code, the state department of education shall compute the average of  
26 the number of pupils enrolling in the course and those completing the same,  
27 and determine for such average number, the per pupil cost thereof course.

28 The amount due the district from the driver training fund in the state  
29 treasury shall be the ~~total cost of operating the program, or the average~~  
30 ~~of the number enrolling in the course and those completing the same course,~~  
31 multiplied by one hundred ~~twenty five~~ fifty dollars (~~\$125~~150), ~~whichever is~~  
32 ~~the lesser.~~

33 b. On or before the fifteenth day of February, and the thirtieth  
34 day of June, and the fifteenth day of September in each year, the state  
35 superintendent of public instruction shall certify to the state controller  
36 a list of school districts having submitted the reports required in section  
37 33-1706, Idaho Code, and the amount of money due to each as computed under  
38 the provisions of subsection a. of this section. The state controller shall  
39 draw his warrants against the driver training account in the state treasury,  
40 in favor of the several districts entitled thereto, in the amount so

1 certified. Annually, not later than the first day of September in each year,  
2 the state superintendent of public instruction shall cause the supervisor of  
3 driver training to prepare a report listing the names of the school districts  
4 having submitted the reports as required in section 33-1706, Idaho Code, and  
5 the amounts of money paid each as computed under the provisions of subsection  
6 a. of this section.
