- REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE BOARD OF TAX APPEALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010; 2 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE BOARD OF TAX APPEALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; 3 LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND 4 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 5
- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 6

7 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 180, Laws of 2009, to the Board 8 of Tax Appeals is hereby reduced by the following amount according to the 9 designated expense classes from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2009, 10 through June 30, 2010: 11 FOR: 12 Personnel Costs 13 \$37,600 Operating Expenditures 9,000 14 TOTAL 15 \$46,600 FROM: 16 General Fund \$46,600

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Tax Appeals in 18 the Department of Revenue and Taxation the following amounts to be expended 19 according to the designated expense classes from the listed fund for the pe-20 riod July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011: 21 22 FOR:

SECTION 3. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Board 28 of Tax Appeals is authorized no more than six (6) full-time equivalent posi-29 tions at any point during the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, for 30 the program specified in Section 2 of this act, unless specifically autho-31 rized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be 32 notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized. 33

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 34 declared to exist, Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on 35 and after passage and approval. 36
