AN ACT

RELATING TO THE IDAHO STATE BAR; AMENDING SECTION 3-405, IDAHO CODE, TO
REVISE A DEFINITION AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 3-405, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
amended to read as follows:

3-405. MEMBER OF THE IDAHO STATE BAR DEFINED. All persons who have been
heretofore, or shall hereafter be, duly admitted to practice law before the
~~S~~supreme ~~C~~court of this state, and who have not been disbarred or suspended
therefrom, and who shall have paid the license fee in this ~~Act~~ chapter
provided for, and all attorney magistrates, judges of the district court
and court of appeals, and ~~S~~supreme ~~C~~courts justices of this state, and of
the district court of the United States for Idaho, are hereby declared to be
members of the Idaho ~~S~~tate ~~B~~ar.
