SENATE BILL NO. 1274

BY KELLY, WERK, MALEPEAI, BILYEU, BOCK, STENNETT

AN ACT

RELATING TO A STATE JOBS COUNCIL; TO PROVIDE A SHORT TITLE; AMENDING CHAPTER

8, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-830, IDAHO

CODE, TO CREATE A JOBS COUNCIL IN THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR AND TO

PROVIDE DUTIES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING A SUNSET DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This act shall be known and may be cited as "The Idaho Jobs Council Act."

SECTION 2. That Chapter 8, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 67-830, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

67-830. STATE JOBS COUNCIL. There is hereby created in the office of the governor a state jobs council composed of the director of the department of commerce, the director of the department of labor, the governor or his representative, a representative of the high-tech industry, a representative of the agricultural industry, a representative of the manufacturing industry, a private citizen who is not a registered lobbyist, and a member of each political party from the house of representatives and the senate and any other public officials or private citizens. The council's duties shall be evaluating homegrown and imported job potential with an emphasis on high wage jobs over thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) per year with full benefit packages. The council shall develop and report specific recommendations for growing jobs in the state within the next three (3) years. A first report shall be submitted to the governor and the legislature by September 15, 2010, and a final report shall be submitted to the governor and the legislature by January 15, 2011. The report shall contain detailed recommended actions to be taken by the governor, state agencies, the legislature and the private sector. Members of the council shall be compensated as provided in section 59-509(b), Idaho Code.

SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval and shall be null, void and of no force and effect on and after April 15, 2011.
