AN ACT

1 RELATING TO VEHICLE AND VESSEL TITLES; AMENDING SECTION 49-502, IDAHO
2 CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE DELIVERY OF CERTIFICATE
3 OF TITLE UPON SALE OR DISPOSITION, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO
4 CERTAIN DEALER'S REASSIGNMENT OF EXISTING CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR OF AN
5 APPLICATION FOR DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL
6 CORRECTIONS.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 49-502, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 49-502. DELIVERY OF CERTIFICATE OF TITLE UPON SALE OR DISPOSITION --
12 REASSIGNMENT BY DEALERS. (1) No person shall sell or otherwise dispose of
13 a vehicle without delivery to the purchaser or transferee a certificate of
14 title with an assignment as necessary to show title in the purchaser, ~~nor~~
15 transferee.

16 (2) The owner shown on the records of the department of any vehicle that
17 is at least ten (10) years old or over sixteen thousand (16,000) pounds gross
18 vehicle weight or has no odometer device, or of any vessel whose certificate
19 of title has become lost, mutilated or illegible, may dispose of such
20 vehicle or vessel by delivering to the purchaser or transferee a completed
21 application for duplicate title, together with an assignment as necessary
22 to show title in the purchaser or transferee. To obtain a certificate of
23 title, the purchaser or transferee shall pay the fees pursuant to section
24 49-202(2)(b) and (c), Idaho Code.

25 (3) No person shall purchase or otherwise acquire or bring into the
26 state a vehicle except for temporary use as provided by section 49-432, Idaho
27 Code, unless he shall obtain a certificate of title in his name in accordance
28 with the provisions of this chapter.

29 (4) Any dealer holding current Idaho dealer license plates may, in
30 lieu of having a certificate of title issued in his name, reassign either
31 any existing certificate of title issued in this state or any application of
32 duplicate certificate of title completed pursuant to subsection (2) of this
33 section.
