6	CONDITION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPLICATION OF CERTAIN LAWS AND RILLES

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 35, Title 25, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and 10 designated as Section 25-3514B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

25-3514B. TRAP, STERILIZATION AND RELEASE OF FREE-ROAMING CATS -- EXEMPTION. Any county or municipality may enact ordinances, rules or resolutions to allow, and otherwise regulate, the humane capture, sterilization and release of free-roaming cats in their jurisdiction for the purpose of population control, provided the person performing the sterilization of the cat is a licensed veterinarian, and this activity shall not be construed to be cruel, neglectful or an act of abandonment under the provisions of this chapter.
