That Section 39-4804, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 13 amended to read as follows: 14 39-4804. NOTIFICATION TO PARENT OR GUARDIAN. (1) Before an immuniza-15 tion is administered to any child in this state, the parent or guardian of the 16 child shall be notified that: 17 (1a) Immunizations are not mandatory and may be refused on religious or 18 other grounds; 19 20 (2b) Participation in the immunization registry is voluntary; $(\frac{3}{2}c)$ The parent or guardian is entitled to an accurate explanation of 21 the complications known to follow such immunization. 22 (2) At the time information is initially collected regarding any child 23 for entry into the registry created pursuant to this chapter, the parent or 24 guardian shall be notified that: 25 (a) They have the right under Idaho law to submit a statement pursuant 26 to the provisions of sections 39-1118 and 39-4802, Idaho Code, which ex-27 empts them from any requirement to have information regarding the child 28 entered into the registry; 29 (b) At any time they have the right to remove any information from the 30 registry regarding the child; and 31 (c) Immunizations are not mandatory and may be refused on religious or 32 33 other grounds. 34 (3) The decision of a parent or guardian to: (a) Submit a statement pursuant to the provisions of either section 35 36 39-1118(2) or 39-4802(2), Idaho Code; (b) Remove any information regarding the child from the registry pur-37 suant to the provisions of section 39-4803(4), Idaho Code; or 38 39 (c) Refuse the immunization on religious or other grounds;

1 shall not be used in any manner against the interests of the parent or 2 guardian in any administrative, civil or criminal action.".
