On page 6 of the printed bill, in line 7, delete "an Idaho address" and insert: "the address of a law enforcement officer's employing entity."; delete lines 8 through 10; in line 15, delete "or former employing entity"; delete lines 24 through 26, and insert:

"(d) A sworn statement by the law enforcement officer that such officer knowingly and voluntarily designates his or her employing entity as agent for purposes of service of process and receipt of first class, certified or registered mail.";

in line 36, delete "or former justice,"; in line 37, delete "judge, magistrate, prosecuting attorney,"; in line 38, following "correctional officer" delete "and" and insert: ","; in line 39, following "officer" insert: "and any person who prosecutes criminal cases"; also in line 39, following "." insert: "The term "law enforcement officer" shall not include a person who holds an elected office.".

On page 7, in line 33, following "chapter" insert: "for a period of four (4) years. Thereafter, law enforcement officers may renew the exemption by submitting a new application and fee, if any"; in line 39, following "on all" insert: "applications and on all"; in line 45, following "to be a" insert: "law enforcement officer or a"; also in line 45, following "member(s)." insert: "Within thirty (30) days of such cessation, the person shall notify, in writing, every public agency to which the person has made an application stating that he or she is no longer eligible for such exemption. If a law enforcement officer changes employment but is still eligible for an exemption under this chapter, such law enforcement officer shall, within thirty (30) days of changing employment, submit a new application to every public agency to which such officer has made an application."; and in line 48, following "member(s)." insert: "A law enforcement officer who has submitted an application pursuant to the provisions of this chapter shall provide his or her current Idaho residential street address to his or her employing entity.".

On page 8, in line 1, delete "governmental entity" and insert: "public agency".

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3

On page 9, in line 2, following "administration." insert: "If an applicant has submitted an application pursuant to the provisions of chapter 58, title 19, Idaho Code, then the applicant may state, in his or her application pursuant to this section, the applicant's alternative Idaho mailing address in place of his or her Idaho residence address and mailing address."; and in line 17, delete "If" and delete lines 18 through 21.
