SENATE BILL NO. 1402

BY FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010;
2 PROVIDING THAT THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER
3 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SHALL DIRECT THE STATE CONTROLLER
4 TO LIMIT THE FUNDS TRANSFER TO THE LEGISLATIVE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR
5 2010; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL FOR
6 FISCAL YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL FOR
7 FISCAL YEAR 2011; DIRECTING THE STATE CONTROLLER TO TRANSFER DEDICATED
8 FUNDS; REAPPROPRIATING CERTAIN UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED BALANCES;
9 PROVIDING THAT THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER
10 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SHALL DIRECT THE STATE CONTROLLER TO
11 LIMIT THE FUNDS TRANSFER TO THE LEGISLATIVE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011;
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR SECTIONS 1, 2 AND 3 OF THIS ACT.

14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

15 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
16 the General Fund appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 226, Laws of 2009,
17 to the Legislative Council is hereby reduced by the following amounts ac-
18 cording to the designated programs for the period July 1, 2009, through June
19 30, 2010:

25 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE TRANSFER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010. Upon passage
26 of this act, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the
27 House of Representatives shall direct the State Controller to limit the
28 amount transferred from the General Fund to the Legislative Fund pursuant
29 to Section 67-451(2), Idaho Code, to \$5,905,100 for the period July 1, 2009,
30 through June 30, 2010.

31 SECTION 3. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter
32 226, Laws of 2009, there is hereby appropriated \$40,000 from the Miscella-
33 neous Revenue Fund to the Legislative Council for the Legislative Services
34 Office for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010.

1 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Council the
 2 following amounts to be expended from the listed funds for the period July 1,
 3 2010, through June 30, 2011:

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18 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 63-2520(5) and
 19 57-1108, Idaho Code, on or about July 1, 2010, the State Controller is hereby
 20 directed to transfer \$500,000 from the Permanent Building Fund dedicated
 21 for relocation to the Miscellaneous Revenue Fund for Capitol Services in the
 22 Legislative Services Office for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30,
 23 2011.

24 SECTION 6. There is hereby reappropriated to the Legislative Council
 25 for the Legislative Services Office the unexpended and unencumbered appro-
 26 priation balances of the Permanent Building Fund, the Miscellaneous Revenue
 27 Fund, and the Professional Services Fund, any appropriation or reappropria-
 28 tion contained in Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, Chapter 226, and Section 19, Chapter
 29 275, Laws of 2009, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures for the period
 30 July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

31 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE TRANSFER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011. On July 1, 2010,
 32 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-
 33 sentatives shall direct the State Controller to limit the amount transferred
 34 from the General Fund to the Legislative Fund pursuant to Section 67-451(2),
 35 Idaho Code, to \$5,905,100 for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.

36 SECTION 8. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 37 declared to exist, Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be in full force and
 38 effect on and after passage and approval.
