SECTION 3. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Commission on Aging is authorized no more than fifteen and thirty-five hundredths (15.35) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, for the program specified in Section 2 of this act, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 4. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval.
