SENATE BILL NO. 1436

AN ACT

1 REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE AMERICAN LUNG ASSOCIATION FOR FISCAL  
2 YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE COMMISSION ON HISPANIC AFFAIRS  
3 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING MONEYS FROM THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM  
4 INCOME FUND AND DIRECTING THE STATE CONTROLLER TO TRANSFER MONEYS FOR  
5 THE PURPOSES AND PROGRAMS SPECIFIED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; APPROPRIATING  
6 MONEYS FROM THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM INCOME FUND TO THE STATE TREASURER FOR  
7 THE PURPOSES AND PROGRAMS SPECIFIED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; DIRECTING A  
8 TRANSFER FROM THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM INCOME FUND TO THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM  
9 FUND; PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEYS SHALL  
10 BE REVERTED TO THE IDAHO MILLENNIUM INCOME FUND; AND DECLARING AN  
11 EMERGENCY.

13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

14 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
15 the appropriation made in Section 2(a), Chapter 211, Laws of 2009, to the  
16 American Lung Association is hereby reduced by the following amount accord-  
17 ing to the designated expense class from the listed fund for the period July  
18 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010:

22 Idaho Millennium Income Fund \$11,000

23 SECTION 2. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-  
24 ter 211, Laws of 2009, there is hereby appropriated and the State Controller  
25 is hereby directed to make cash transfers from the Idaho Millennium Income  
26 Fund at the request of the State Treasurer to the Commission on Hispanic Af-  
27 fairs the following amount to be expended according to the designated ex-  
28 pense class from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2009, through June  
29 30, 2010:

34 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated and the State Controller is  
35 hereby directed to make cash transfers from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund  
36 to the following programs, at the request of the State Treasurer, not to  
37 exceed \$2,325,000 for the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011:

1 (a) \$500,000 for the Public Health Districts to continue tobacco use  
2 cessation programs statewide through the Public Health Districts of  
3 Idaho and other nonprofit entities such as hospitals, primary care  
4 clinics and voluntary organizations. The tobacco use cessation pro-  
5 grams should be available to any Idaho citizen, with primary emphasis on  
6 youth and pregnant women.

7 (b) \$600,000 for the Physical Health Services Program in the Depart-  
8 ment of Health and Welfare for targeted tobacco counter-marketing pro-  
9 grams, specific to Idaho, and to be matched by private industry funds on  
10 at least a one-to-one basis.

11 (c) \$700,000 for the Physical Health Services Program in the Department  
12 of Health and Welfare. It is legislative intent that these funds shall  
13 be designated for nicotine replacement therapy, and that these funds  
14 shall not be used for local programs identified in the department's  
15 application proposal since they may duplicate other programs funded by  
16 the Millennium Income Fund.

17 (d) \$420,000 for the Idaho Supreme Court for its youth courts, tobacco  
18 and alcohol diversion courts, and status offender services programs as  
19 they relate to addressing tobacco and/or substance abuse issues.

20 (e) \$94,000 for Law Enforcement Programs in the Idaho State Police to  
21 offset the cost of youth tobacco investigations.

22 (f) \$11,000 for the Youth Tobacco Prevention Programs in conjunction  
23 with the American Lung Association in the Commission on Hispanic Af-  
24 fairs.

25 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated from the Idaho Millennium  
26 Income Fund to the State Treasurer \$1,041,900 to be expended for trustee and  
27 benefit payments for the following programs for the period July 1, 2010,  
28 through June 30, 2011:

29 (a) \$181,900 for the American Lung Association of Idaho for Teens  
30 Against Tobacco Use (T.A.T.U.) and tobacco prevention education pro-  
31 grams.

32 (b) \$500,000 for the Idaho Meth Project for a drug prevention media cam-  
33 paign.

34 (c) \$150,000 for Idaho Drug Free Youth for the i2i program.

35 (d) \$150,000 for the American Cancer Society for the Women's Health  
36 Check cancer screening program.

37 (e) \$60,000 for the Idaho Academy of Family Physicians for the Tar Wars  
38 program.

1           SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated and the State Controller is di-  
2           rected to transfer \$220,800 from the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to be de-  
3           posited in the Idaho Millennium Fund for the period July 1, 2010, through  
4           June 30, 2011.

5           SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
6           on June 30, 2011, any remaining unexpended and unencumbered moneys appropri-  
7           ated in Section 3 of this act shall be reverted to the Idaho Millennium Income  
8           Fund. The State Controller shall then transfer said reverted moneys and all  
9           earnings credited to the Idaho Millennium Income Fund to the Idaho Millen-  
10          nium Fund.

11          SECTION 7. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
12          declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-  
13          fect on and after passage and approval.
