STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE PUB LIC HEALTH DISTRICTS RELATING TO RULES OF IDAHO PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive 7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the 8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with 9 legislative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the 11 Public Health Districts relating to Rules of Idaho Public Health District 12 No. 1 is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 41.01.01, Rules of Idaho Public Health District No. 1, Section 100, Water Quality Control, Subsection 06.c, the last two sentences, only, a final rule, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
