A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND WELFARE RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING CERTIFIED
FAMILY HOMES.
Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive 7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the 8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with 9 legislative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the 11 Department of Health and Welfare relating to Rules Governing Certified Fam-12 ily Homes is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 16.03.19, Rules Governing Certified Family Homes, Section 701, Manufactured Homes, Subsection 01.a, only, a final rule, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
